

Summer Camp Scholarship Application

Extended Deadline to apply is Monday, May 28, 2018

Our Scholarship Program offers an opportunity to students with a keen interest and ability in science, medicine, arts and the outdoors who may not be able to afford full registration fees. Each scholarship includes all instruction, materials and field trip expenses. *Students awarded a scholarship will need to provide a \$25 non-refundable deposit in order to attend.* These scholarships are provided through generous gifts from various businesses, foundations and individuals that believe in supporting science and health education programs at the Cleveland Museum of Natural History.

Drop-off and pick-up for all camps will be at The Cleveland Museum of Natural History. Drop-off begins at 8:30 am. We do not provide before or after care. Students must provide their own lunch each day of camp (except Future Scientists).

Junior Medical Camp (JMC) is a summer day camp that explores the science behind medicine and health. Loaded with hands-on labs and fun activities, Junior Medical Camps are for students entering grades 6-12 who are interested in learning about medical careers. Students will attend grade-appropriate sessions at the Cleveland Museum of Natural History and learn about microbiology, genetics, forensic science, toxicology, veterinary medicine, physical therapy and other topics. Each week includes interviews with health and medical professionals and a field trip to a health science facility. Upon submission of the scholarship application, qualified JMC II and JMC III applicants will be contacted to schedule a brief phone interview. JMC runs from 9 am to 4:30 pm daily.

Outdoor Education Camps focus on experiential, hands-on learning in natural environments. Outdoor Education Camps are for students entering grades 6-12. Each program is designed to inspire and excite participants about the natural world through exploration, participation in Museum research, and by conducting real scientific fieldwork. Participants are encouraged to get outside, get messy, and make new discoveries! Upon submission of the scholarship application, qualified Future Scientists applicants will be contacted to schedule a brief phone interview. Most Outdoor Education camps run from 9 am to 4:30 pm daily.

Rocket Camp is a summer day camp for students entering grades 6-8 in which campers will gain an understanding of how Newton's Laws got astronauts to the Moon and apply that knowledge as you build and launch your own advanced rocket! Students will have the opportunity to build multiple rockets throughout the week. The final day will include an off-site trip for an epic series of launches. Rocket Camp runs from 9 am to 4:30 pm daily.

- Provide a written statement from your school office stating eligibility for reduced price or free meals (does not apply for students in the Cleveland Metropolitan School District and Cleveland Hts-University Hts School District). Homeschooling families: see info on last page.

A panel of education and management staff from the Cleveland Museum of Natural History will review all applications. Scholarship recipients will be notified via email or phone no later than May 18th. All information is confidential.
