- If you have any handouts, materials, additional resources, how to sheets, or anything else you would like to have distributed to students this Wed., you will need to have the materials prepared and placed by you assigned section in the gym. These materials will have to be ready by early Tuesday afternoon so they can be set up before wed. morning.
- · I will be sending an updated email & password along with an updated ELL student list later this evening.
- Earlier in the week I sent instructions on how to see up to 49 students using teams. This is a great feature and will help you better manage your students. Please let me know if you need further support in getting it working.
- Continue to populate and update the engagement documents in the Engagement and Supports Teams folder. Our goal
  is to attempt to contact non-engaged students at lease once per day. We are here to support, but can't unless the
  document is being populated and updated daily.
