This past week we had an uptick of aggressive behaviors. These displays of aggression often seem to feed off of each other and are toxic to the overall culture of our building. Take a moment this Monday and Tuesday to assess the culture of your classrooms. Is it negative or positive? Give student the opportunity to openly discuss some of the negative behaviors that have been taking place and give them a platform to think through and propose solutions. Now is the time to proactively address these issues with your scholars.

As a follow up to your class discussions we will be conducting 2 assemblies at the beginning of the week after break.

On the Monday, December $2^{\rm nd}$, we will be meeting with students in grade 1-3 in the breakfast room for a short assembly. At the assembly we will discuss many of the negative behaviors that have been observed throughout the building. These include: the use of profane language, fighting, bullying, negative self-talk, and the general disrespect of teachers and classmates. We will also be celebrating our PATHs scholars and many of the positive things that are happening as well.

We will be meeting with students in grades 4-8 separately on December $3^{\rm rd}$ and follow a similar format. I have not yet decided on a time and location for this meeting and will announce it later in the week after talking to grade level teams.

Moving forward I would like to conduct more frequent and regular grade band assemblies. If you are interested in contributing to the agenda and have issues you would like addressed on a broader level, please forward me your thoughts or stop by my office to discuss.

11 Disruption, 11 Physical Aggression, 5 Fighting & 4 Abusive Language

We continue to see disruption and physical aggression as common infractions. Disruption of the learning environment cannot be tolerated but it is also important to ensure that students are engaged so that disruption is not occurring. We also want to ensure that our interactions with our students do not increase the disruption. Always remember to redirect privately when possible and try to use a calm voice. For a student that you believe is not responding to Tier I supports, consider starting a behavior contract with the student. If you have a student that you have concerns with, please reach out to Mrs. Beets, Mr. Myslenski, or Mrs. Pascella to discuss other interventions and supports.
