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## Campus International School Uniform Guidelines

Campus International follows Cleveland Metropolitan School District guidelines for uniform, which can be found online in the CMSD Student Code of Conduct (pages 4-7). A convenient reference guide is below:

| <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Types:</b> Students may wear collared button-up shirts (oxfords), polo shirts, dress-shirts or blouses, or turtlenecks. <i>Shirts must be tucked in.</i></li> <li>• <b>Colors &amp; Patterns –</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Tops must be solid colors (no stripes) and may not include insignia or logos other than the CIS logo.</li> <li>○ Tops must be blue, white, or green (school colors). Black and gray are also acceptable.</li> </ul> </li> </ul> | <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Types:</b> Students may wear skirts, slacks, knee-length shorts, or capris. Corduroys, khakis, dress pants, or uniform pants are appropriate. <i>Students may not wear jeans, sweat suits, pajamas, or exercise pants.</i></li> <li>• <b>Colors &amp; Patterns –</b> Bottoms must be solid colors and can be blue/navy, black, or khaki/tan.</li> <li>• <b>Belts -</b> Belts are required for bottoms that have belt loops. Belts must be black, navy, or brown, and may not include overly adorned belt buckles.</li> </ul> |

### Other Important Uniform Guidelines

**Sweaters & Jackets –** Students may wear cardigans, pullovers, or vests over their uniform shirts. These may be blue, white, or green. *Students may not wear hooded sweatshirts.*

**Headgear –** Students are not permitted to wear headgear in school—including but not limited to scarves, hats, rags, wraps, or any other items identified as unauthorized by the district. *Religious headscarves are an exception to this rule.*

**Exceptions –** Exceptions to the uniform guidelines may be made on a case-by-case basis for individual students to accommodate religious practices or for *other compelling reasons* on an either temporary or long-term basis.

**School Spirit Gear –** Students may wear any CIS shirts in lieu of a uniform shirt on all days *except Mondays.*

**College Fridays –** Every Friday, all members of our school community are encouraged to wear shirts from any college or university and have their picture taken and added to our “Picture Me in College” wall.

**Enforcement –** Students who are out of uniform will be provided with clothing to correct their uniform infraction for the day and families will be notified. Repeated incidences will lead to formulation of a uniform plan between the school, family, and student.
