Basic Education Classes for Adults and Book Club

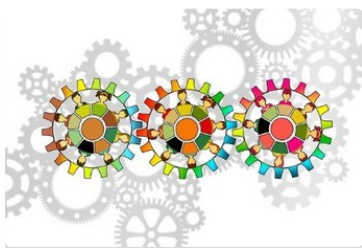
