CMSD expands meal service

CMSD is offering expanded meal service for families during remote learning.

USDA guidelines allow all students in the city of Cleveland (18 and younger) to receive prepackaged lunch and breakfast for free, even if they don't attend a CMSD school. Parents or caregivers can pick up meals for students.

Families should select from one of two meal options:

Pick up a day's supply from 10:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday at any PreK-8 or K-8 school. A double supply will be available on Tuesday. Sites will be closed Wednesday for cleaning and sanitizing.

Stock up for the week from 10:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. on Tuesday at most high schools. Service is not available at the Lakeside Building (Cleveland High School for Digital Arts, Davis Aerospace & Maritime High School), John Hay Campus or MC2STEM locations.

It's time for seniors to fill out the FAFSA

CMSD seniors can begin submitting the Free Application for Federal Student Aid, or FAFSA, a required step toward obtaining funding for college.

The new FAFSA became available on Oct. 1. Seniors who want to enroll in college should fill out the application as soon as possible for the best chance of getting federal and school aid.

Submitting the FAFSA is required to obtain the Say Yes Cleveland scholarships created for CMSD graduates. The scholarships pay up to the full value of tuition, minus federal and state aid, to all public colleges, universities and Pell-eligible training programs in Ohio and more than 100 private colleges and universities across the country.

College Now of Greater Cleveland is holding virtual assistance with the FAFSA as part a series of college application and readiness events. Go to www.collegenowgc.org for further information.

The mission of MAGNET, the Manufacturing Advocacy & Growth Network, is to support, educate and champion manufacturing in Ohio with the goal of transforming the region's economy into a powerful, global player.

Early College Early Career

Developed by MAGNET in conjunction with other organizations, the Early College Early Career program takes students from high school and guides them through a college degree program and subsequent manufacturing career to meet the needs of manufacturers in Northeast Ohio. This initiative offers students company-based, real-world training as well as certification programs that can result in the skilled workforce needed for the region's manufacturing sector.

Cohort 1 started Fall 2017 with students going into their junior year. Cohort 2 started Fall 2018. Cohort 3 will start Fall 2019 and so on.

Graduation Requirements for Class of 2021

Take and earn a state minimum of 22 credits in specific subjects. You also must receive instruction in economics and financial literacy and complete at least two semesters of fine arts.

1. **Ohio's State Tests.**
2. **Industry credential and workforce readiness**
3. **College admission test**
