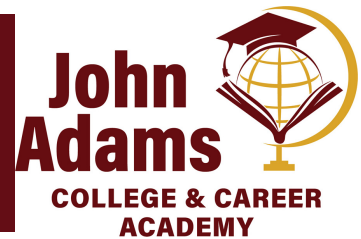


Why Choose JACCA?

MASTERY MODEL

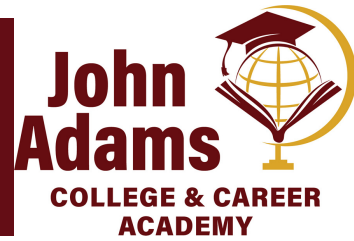

10th Grade Experience: Students will have the option to take intro courses in each of our career-aligned pathways to assist them in identifying their pathway for 11th & 12th grade. Students will also participate in at least one job-shadowing experience this year.

11th & 12th Grade Experience: Students will engage in one of the pathways below. All pathways will include coursework to prepare students for college and/or career, as well as internships and a mentor from the career field that interests them.

ABOUT THE IT PATHWAY

The IT Pathway will will prepare students for careers dealing with information technology (i.e., operations, support, deployment/integration). Students will gain the necessary technical and academic skills to implement computer systems and software, provide technical assistance and manage information systems.

ABOUT THE LSJ PATHWAY

The LSJ Pathway will prepare students for a wide range of careers in the public service industry, as well as build knowledge of criminal and civil law, an understanding of legal procedure and ways to affect community change regarding social justice.
