Ginn Academy Cell Phone Policy

The Ginn Academy believes in maintaining a safe and effective educational environment for all of its students. Research shows that the mere presence of cellphones in the classroom can be detrimental to student performance. The Ginn Academy Cell Phone Policy is designed to create a culture of students disconnected from their phones so that they can connect with learning and instruction.

The Ginn Academy has a **zero tolerance** and **zero use** of cell phones during the instructional day. All cell phones will be collected at the beginning of each school day and placed in a secure location. Students who refuse to comply will receive a mandatory parent conference where the policy will be shared and the family will be given the option to participate or choose a different school. Students who get caught using a phone that was snuck into school will be given the option of choosing a different school. The Ginn Academy is an institution of excellence and failure to comply with the cell phone policy is not an option. We are providing an academic and social environment that is preparing our young men to be leaders. We cannot continue to support students who do not have the same goals.

Technology in the Classroom
