PBIS/CLASSDOJO

At Westropp, we are actively working to maintain a positive school environment.

PBIS

Clara Westropp School will continue using a Positive Behavioral Interventions and Support (PBIS) for the 23-24 school year. School staff will be teaching and reinforcing expectations based on Westropp's 3 main rules:

- □ Be Respectful.
- Be Responsible.
- Be Safe.

This year, we will continue using ClassDojo and Wildcat Bucks as a part of our Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports system for kindergarten through 4th grade students.

Here is how it works:

Teachers use ClassDojo as a tool for students to earn Dojo points for meeting classroom expectations. The first opportunity students have each day to earn a Dojo point is for attendance-coming to school and being here on time. Students can earn 4 or more Dojo points EACH day. Dojo points are tracked through ClassDojo. Students who earn the minimum number of points each month will earn a field trip at the end of the month. <u>Students who DO NOT earn the Dojo points needed to attend the trip will remain in the school with their classroom teacher to work on review or make-up work.</u> Students who have earned the trip MUST have a signed permission slip before they can get on the bus.

Students can also earn Wildcat Bucks from any adult in the building throughout the school day when they are caught meeting building expectations or doing something great. Wildcat bucks can then be use at our PBIS store, where students can purchase snacks and other fun items.
