

EXACT PATH – Content Search

Exact Path by Edmentum is an instructional content tool that can:

1 – Use MAP NWEA results to create an individualized learning path to address gaps in a student’s skills that prevent grade-level mastery.

2 – Help teachers understand student comprehension of Power Standards

Content Search results give several options:

1 – Learning Paths: a trio of lesson + practice + mastery quiz modules. Available in K-5 or 6-12 view.

2 – Resource content videos, lesson ideas (lesson plan, warm up activities, scaffolding, quiz), worksheets.


1. Login

a) Login via Clever - Single Sign-On

b) Select Edmentum Exact Path



c) from Home Screen, Select Content Search



2. Content Search

a) Select 'Search by Standard'

b) Choose Subject, Grade, State Domain, Standard

c) Click 'Go!'

3. Assign Learning Path

a) Preview the Learning Paths

b) Select the Learning Path, click Assign

c) Select Class and all or partial students



EXACT PATH – Looking at Results Overview

The Home screen in Exact Path gives teachers a quick glance at student progress:

- 1 – Notifications for students for the current or previous weeks
- 2 – List students who are struggling; who have failed once or twice on a learning path; or who have a locked mastery quiz because they didn't pass.
- 3 – Each of these issues direct a teacher to intervene with instruction.

The Home screen also gives shortcuts to helpful tools:

- 1 – Create groups, review activities, review overall progress, search for resources.

1. Home Screen

- a) Click on My Classes
- b) On Home screen, filter by subject and timeframe (default current week)
- c) If desired, filter by status: struggling, failed once, etc

2. Custom Groups

- a) Select 'Create Group' from Class Quick Links
 - b) Select subject / domain / skill
 - c) Click Auto-group
- Custom groups can be used for:**
- a) Flexible grouping for classroom instruction
 - b) Assigning additional resources to strugglers
 - c) Assigning additional work for advanced students

3. Student Logins

- a) Students login via Clever
- b) To get their login info: From teacher Clever page, go to classes to print student login credentials or badges
- c) Student home screen differs by grade band: K-2; 3-5; 6-12
- d) Content for learning paths also presented by grade band: K-5; 6-12
