

EXACT PATH – MAP Growth Learning Paths

Exact Path by Edmentum is an instructional content tool that can:

- 1 – Use MAP NWEA results to create an individualized learning path to address gaps in a student’s skills that prevent grade-level mastery.
- 2 – Help teachers understand student comprehension of Power Standards
- 3 – Quickly identify student problem areas by subject and skill.

Once student MAP Growth RIT scores are loaded into Exact Path:

- 1 – Teachers can pull a report that shows RIT scores in terms of grade equivalent broken down by goal. This report can be sorted by goal to inform teacher lesson planning.
- 2 – Loading the scores generates individual learning paths for each student. These paths address 4 skill gaps at a time by providing a lesson, practice, and mastery quiz module for each skill.

1. Login

a) Login via Clever - Single Sign-On

c) from Home Screen, select a subject

2. MAP Growth Reports

- a) Select 'NWEA MAP/Class Results'
- b) Review student RIT score and NWEA Norms data grade equivalent by goal
- c) Sort students by grade equivalent in each goal

3. Home Screen

- a) On Home screen, filter by subject and timeframe (default current week)
- b) If desired, filter by status: struggling, failed once, etc

Student Logins:

- a) Students login via Clever
- b) To get their Clever login info. From teacher Clever page go to Classes to print student login credentials or badges



EXACT PATH – Looking at Results Details

The Home screen in Exact Path gives teachers a quick glance at student progress:


- 1 – Notifications for students for the current or previous weeks
- 2 – List students who are struggling; who have failed once or twice on a learning path; or who have a locked mastery quiz because they didn't pass.
- 3 – Use Quick Links to jump to student progress details.
- 4 – Use Custom Group / Auto-group feature to support classroom activities.

The Home screen also gives shortcuts to helpful tools:



- a) Select 'Review Current Activities' from Class Quick Links
- b) Select the desired subject



- c) Note the different learning paths setup for each student




2. Review Student Mastery Quiz responses

- a) Click on the Knowledge Map tab



- b) Observe student progress and status of their activities, click on any active status block



- c) To see student responses to a Mastery Quiz, Click on 'Review'



3. Uses of Custom Groups

a) Select 'Custom Groups' from Class Quick Links

b) Select subject / domain / skill

c) Click on Auto-group

Custom groups can be used for:

a) Flexible grouping for classroom instruction

b) Assigning additional resources to strugglers

c) Assigning additional work for advanced students
