The Institute for H.O.P.E. School Health Program is partnering with your school district to offer health care services on-site at your child's school. Your child will now have easier medical service access during the school day.

What services does MetroHealth provide?

- Annual physicals
- Sports physicals
- Injury/illness care
- Routine lab tests
- Prescription medications
- Teen services
- Mental/behavioral health
- Immunizations
- Care for chronic conditions, including asthma, allergies, diabetes and seizure disorders
- Health education and prevention
- Telehealth, to supplement in-person care

How can my child participate?

Complete the Institute for H.O.P.E. School Health Program consent packet at metrohealth.org/school-health or at your school office. The program is open to all students who have a signed parental consent form on file, which remains valid while the child attends school in the district.
