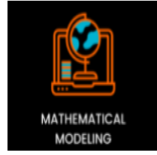

According to The Collaborative for Academic, Social, and Emotional Learning (CASEL), "social and emotional learning (SEL) is the process through which children and adults acquire and effectively apply the knowledge, attitudes, and skills necessary to understand and manage emotions, set and achieve positive goals, feel and show empathy for others, establish and maintain positive relationships, and make responsible decisions." Social Emotional Learning is very important to academic learning. Students cannot learn if they are suffering either from anxiety or depression or other issues.

Back to school time can trigger a lot of anxiety and excitement for students of all ages especially since the return to in-person learning. Please remember that patience and kindness go a long way!
