Recently, Mrs. Ramirez completed her Master's Degree in Social Work from Walden University.

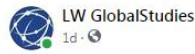

Celebrating Students in A.C.E. Mentorship Program, Crain's CLE

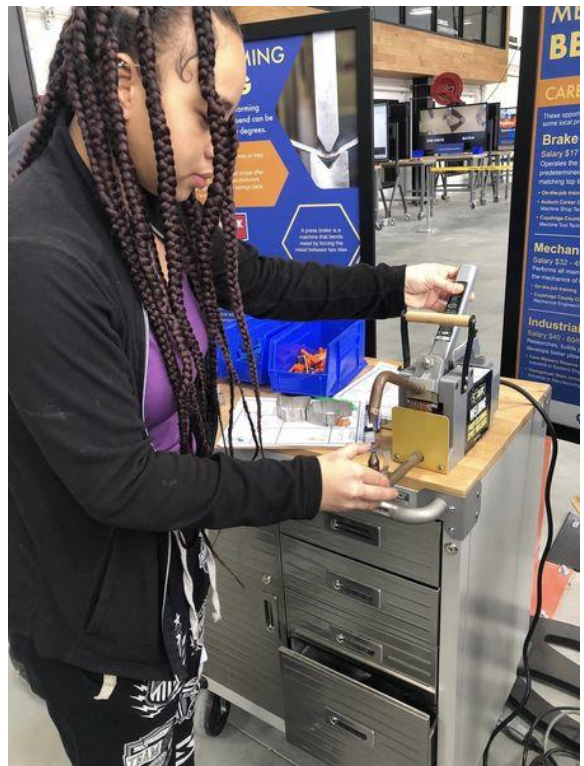
