

Class Coverage is used to compensate Teachers and Paraprofessionals who are needed to cover a class for another employee during the school day.

The list of Class Coverages along with a detailed definition has been updated to identify when and how to use the Coverage Codes for accurate reporting of time worked.

## **Coverage Codes, Descriptions, and Definitions**

TEACHERS ONLY			
Class Coverage Code	Descriptions	Definitions	
C01	Whole Class, 1 Period	Covers one class for 1 period	
C02	Whole Class, All Day	Covers one class for entire day	
C03	1/3 Class, All Day	Covers one-third of one class all day	
C05	1/3 Class, 1/2 Day	Covers one-third of one class for half of a day	
C07	1/2 Class, All Day	Covers half a class for an entire day	
C13	1/3 Class, 1 Period	Covers a third of a class for 1 period	
C17	Whole class 2 periods or a block	Covers 1 class two periods or block	
C19	Para Coverage - Special Ed only	When the regular paraprofessional is out and no substitute paraprofessional is available teacher gets paid = one period
