

Creating Your Own Business and Investing Money with Mr. Solomon and Mr. Taub



This course will cover all the little details that go into creating your own business: making a proposal, designing a logo or a slogan, writing job descriptions, advertising, making cost projections and generating revenue. Students will also compete in a stock market competition and learn about different money investment strategies!

Diagnostic and Emergency Medicine Bootcamp with Ms. Busher-Betancourt and Ms. Swaggard-Svec



Come and learn applications of science in medicine! In this two hour session, you will be engaged in becoming certified in both First Aid and CPR. You will learn how to perform diagnostic tests and prescribe treatments for an outbreak on a college campus. You will then pass this knowledge on to others at the CSSM Health Fair! Expressive Art and Music Self-Therapy with Ms. Edwards and Ms . Mortensen



■ In this course, you will experience and learn about Art and Music Therapy. Art Therapy can be a great way to relax and help individuals deal with the negative and focus on and appreciate the good. Consider this class if you want to feel better, relieve stress and then share your experience with others at the CSSM Health Fair. We will meditatively paint, make word association collages, create musical poems and take a field trip to see Music and Art Therapy in action.

The Holocaust and Bioethics with Ms. Gabriel



This course will delve into the social, political, and economic climate in Germany in the 1930s and 1940s, which allowed the Holocaust to take place. Then, we will discuss the bioethical issues such as humans as research subjects, eugenics, and the Hippocratic Oath vs. Government Policies.

Medical Malpractice and Mock Trial with Mr. Trepal



This course will cover both the substantive and procedural aspects of medical malpractice litigation from the perspectives of both the plaintiffs and defendants in medical malpractice litigation. Using court case materials, students will play the role of witness and attorney in a Mock Trial Case setting. The case will revolve around the expert testimony of medical professionals involved in a medical malpractice lawsuit.

PsychoThriller with Mr. Krupa



This course will explore the psychology of fear and how it relates to select stories and excerpted texts of literature. We will examine research on the anatomy of fear, why we like to be afraid, what classically frightens us, and how given literature reflects the more disturbing aspects of given psychological maladies. Authors like Stephen King, Graham Greene, Flannery O'Connor, Edgar Allen Poe, J.D. Salinger and others will provide us with the "case studies" upon which we can make our diagnoses and analysis.

The Role of Journaling in Reducing Stress and Anxiety with Ms. Porter and Ms. Sims




This course will allow students to create blank books/journals, discover the use of journaling as a stress and anxiety reducer, and conduct action research about the process to present at the Health Fair. Students will have the opportunity to journal daily and meta-cognitively discuss the process to collect data, conduct research on the benefits of journaling and prepare a presentation for the CSSM Health Fair on June 12, 2019.

Service Learning and Grant Writing Workshop with Mr. Krishnan and Anita Johnson



This course will provide students with the opportunity to help identify foundations, corporations, and government grant programs and to learn how to approach different kinds of grantmakers. Students will develop the skills needed to write a winning proposal by avoiding common mistakes that applicants make, developing realistic objectives, and determining appropriate budgets. The Unexpected Freedom of Form (a poetry writing workshop) with Ms. Perez
