What is Sexual Harassment?

Sexual harassment is any unwelcome prohibited conduct of a sexual nature which has the purpose or effect of unreasonably interfering with an individual's performance, creating an intimidating, hostile, or offensive educational or work environment, or limiting participation in District activities.

Some Examples of Sexual Harassment

Pressure for a dating, romantic, or intimate relationship Unwelcome touching, kissing, hugging, or massaging Pressure for or forced sexual activity Unnecessary references to parts of the body Remarks about a person's gender or sexual orientation Sexual innuendoes or humor, Obscene gestures, Sexual graffiti, pictures, or posters Sexually-explicit profanity Stalking, Sexual assault Includes: Rape, Fondling, Statutory rape
