#### Welcome to the East Tech family!


The year 2020 has brought so many changes, it may seem hard to keep up. This document is for East Tech students and their guardians to help everyone navigate the virtual environment.

All students need to be able to log into their CMSD email and Teams accounts. Those enrolled in 9th and 10th grade will also need to log in to our Learning Management System (LMS) called ECHO in order access and submit schoolwork.

The first priority is logging in to CMSD email and Teams accounts so students can communicate with their teachers. Students access Teams through Outlook, using their CMSD email address. This will also grant students access to Clever and Schoology which are also used for some or all of their classes.

Students in 9th and 10th grade need to access Echo, the website where students can access content and submit assignments. Student Echo accounts also contain the virtual gradebook allowing all to monitor schoolwork.

## **New Tech Network Information**

<u>New Tech Network</u> is a group of about 200 schools across the country and Australia that share four design principles, and use a common learning management system, **ECHO**.

- <u>Teaching that Engages</u> Through project-based learning, teachers become curriculum designers and students learn to be collaborative problem solvers.
- <u>Outcomes that Matter</u> New Tech Network learning outcomes also measure collaboration, written and oral communication and the development of student responsibility for their own learning and agency.
- <u>Culture that Empowers</u> By making learning relevant and creating a collaborative learning culture, students become connected to, engaged with, and challenged by their school, their teachers and their peers.
- <u>Technology that Enables</u> Through a technology-rich environment, teachers and students create, communicate, access information, and experience self-directed learning.
