

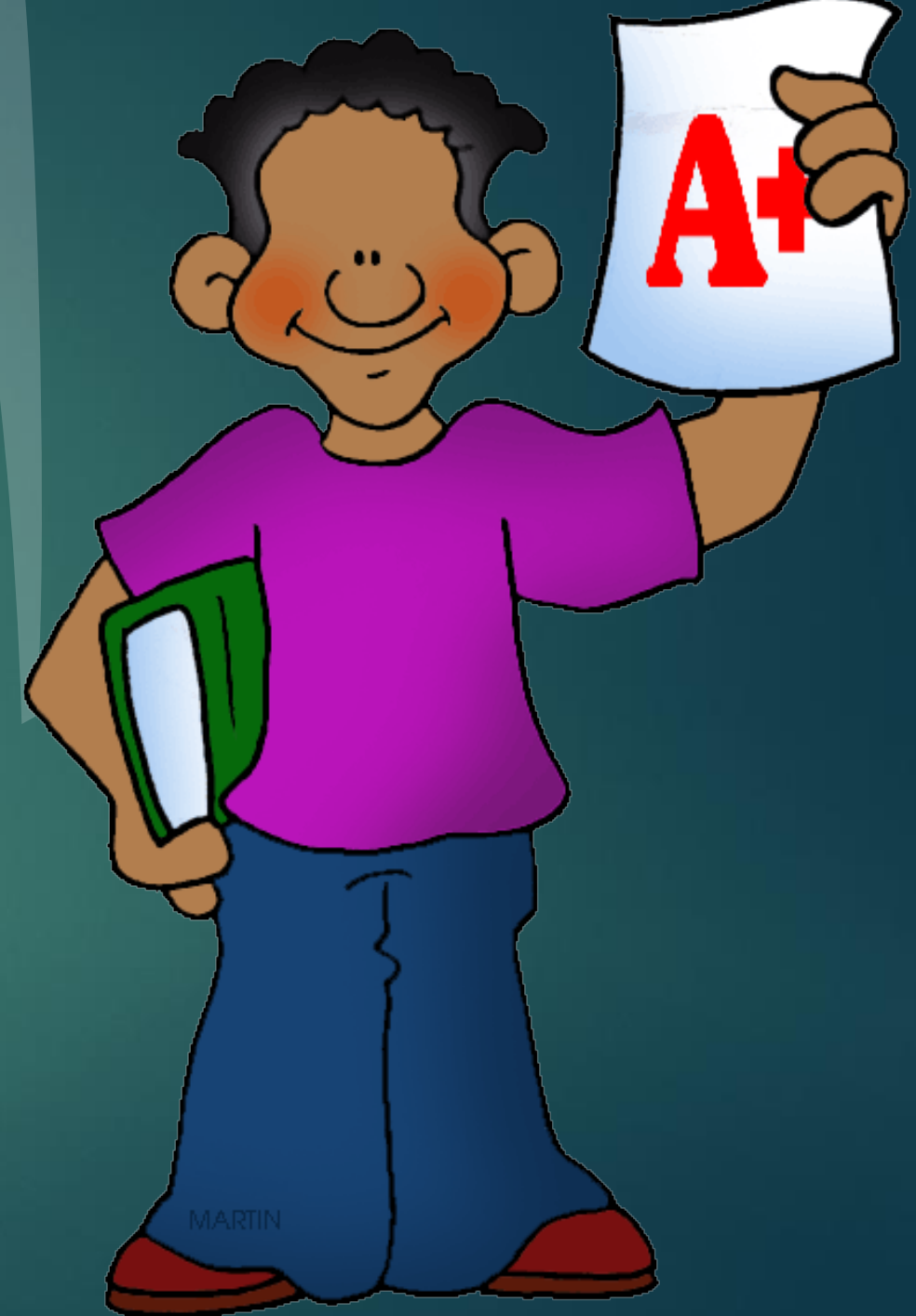

- ▶ **All 8th grade students in-person and REMOTE will be able to attend**



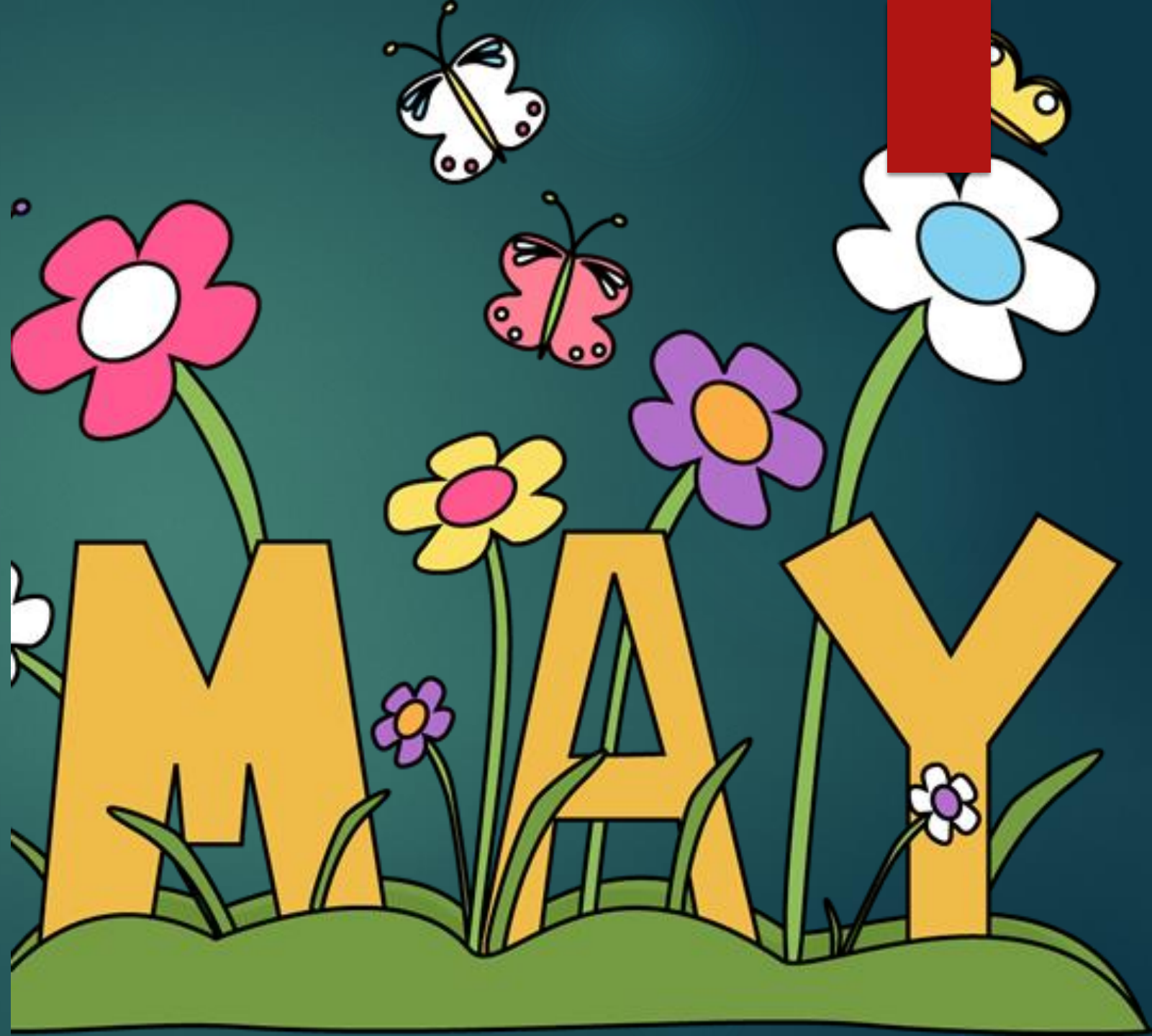
COVID-19 Procedures
