Wade Park 2021-2022 STUDENT UNIFORM DRESS CODE

Wade Park believes that a positive learning environment is an important factor in attaining student achievement. There are many factors that lead to a positive learning environment. We believe that wearing school uniforms promotes safety, improve discipline, and enhances the overall academic environment.

1st-4th UNIFORM DRESS CODE:

- Shirt (polo/dress shirt): White (preferred color), blue, grey, black, red
- Pants/Skirts/Skorts/Shorts: khaki, black, blue, grey
- Shoes: No color requirements. No slippers, sandals, or open toe shoes.

5th-8th UNIFORM DRESS CODE:

- Tie: Any color tie (Red is the preferred color) *one tie is provided
 - o All 5th-8th graders are required to wear a tie on Monday, Tuesday, & Thursday.
- Shirt (polo/dress shirt): White (preferred color), blue, grey, black, red
- Pants/Skirts/Skorts/Shorts: khaki, black, blue, grey
- **Shoes:** No color requirements. No slippers, sandals, or open toe shoes.

SPIRIT DAY DRESS CODE:
