Gray Wolves

Gray wolves travel in groups, although sometimes a wolf will go off on its own to start a new pack. These are called dispersing wolves. Wolves travel long distances. They usually go about 5 miles per hour; however, they can run as fast as 37 miles per hour when they are chasing prey. In addition to hidden cameras, scientists sometimes put Global Positioning System (GPS) collars on the wolves to follow them.
