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## **Technology Update**

Attention Paul L. Dunbar families: CMSD provides a digital device for every district student. The device is district property and students should follow the guidelines and CMSD Acceptable Use and Internet Safety policy for students. Please send ALL broken and damaged devices back to school, <u>regardless of the condition</u>.

#### WE WILL NOT BE ABLE TO ISSUE A NEW DEVICE UNTIL THE OLD ONE IS RETURNED

Student Device Replacement Guidelines:

- First Incident: A second device will be provided by the district without requiring a fee.
- Second Incident: the district will require the student and guardian to attend a device care webinar or pay a \$50 fee for the device.
- Third Incident: the District will require intervention for a fourth device replacement from a School Support Team.

\*Exception: If a device is damaged, and it is determined by the school building administration that the device was intentionally damaged, the student will be responsible for the full cost of the device.
