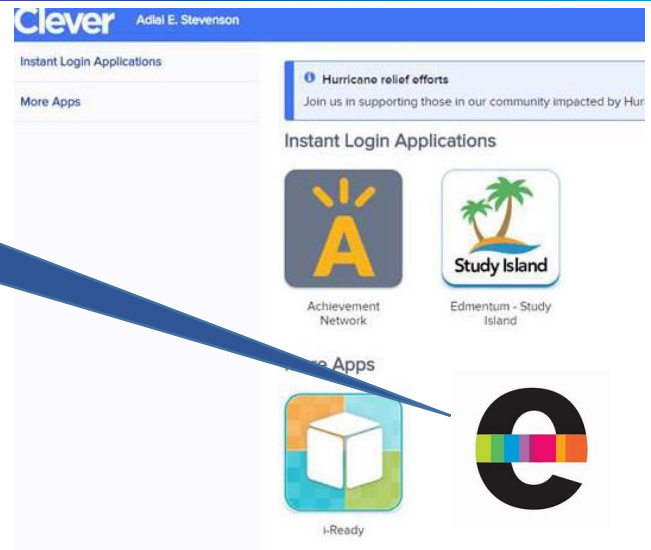

Grade 3-5 View

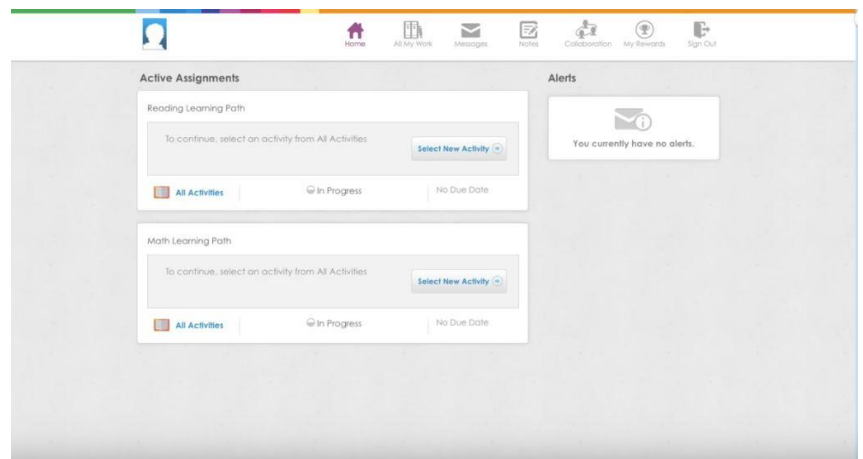
Each Learning Path contains a list of skills to work on that has been created specifically for your child based on their test score history
