

# PSAT/NMSQT TESTING

For this year **only**, due to the Covid-19 pandemic CMSD families may choose whether to have their high school student take the PSAT/NMSQT. Only currently enrolled 11th grade students attending a CMSD school are eligible to register. This test is not mandatory this year, however, registration is required.

The District realizes the importance of this assessment and that families may want their child to participate in the PSAT/NMSQT testing opportunity, which is a great way for students to kick off their path to college and earn scholarships.

The College Board has not provided an option for districts to administer this exam remotely, therefore, testing will be conducted in person at our school buildings.

The designated testing date for the PSAT/NMSQT is **Tuesday, January 26**, which will be administered as a paper-only exam. Students are required to wear a facemask and bring a photo ID (state driver's license). Students will not be permitted inside the building without having a facemask and photo ID. This will be a timed test and students will be permitted to leave at the conclusion of the assessment. Early dismissals will not be permitted. Non-testers will not be permitted to enter buildings due to social distancing guidelines.

The District will provide each student with a pencil, test booklet and answer sheet. Upon arrival, mandatory temperature checks will be conducted prior to entering the testing site. Students who arrive late will not be permitted to enter the building.
