

2024-2025 SCHOOL UNIFORM POLICY

Dear RHJ Families,

I hope you are having a safe and enjoyable summer. Jamison will be implementing a mandatory uniform policy for the 2024-2025 school year. After speaking with families throughout the 2023-2024 school year and surveying our families at the end of the year, an overwhelming 73% of families expressed a preference for a uniform policy at Jamison. In addition, over 60% of families felt that a school uniform would improve the learning environment, increase school pride, and promote positive behavior.

We are excited to begin the new school year with uniforms and expect all Jamison scholars to uphold the dress code outlined below:

Uniform Item	Expectation
School Logo Polo Shirt (Provided by the school)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> REQUIRED ON MONDAYS Required: School logo polo shirt. Long-sleeve solid color shirts are allowed under polo.
Solid Color Polo Shirt	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> REQUIRED TUESDAY THROUGH THURSDAY Required: BLACK, WHITE, or PURPLE solid color polo shirt. NO logos, words, or insignias. Long-sleeve solid color shirts are allowed under polo.
School Logo T-Shirt (Provided by the school)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> REQUIRED ON FRIDAYS Required: School logo T-shirt (or any other Jamison shirt) Long-sleeve solid color shirts are allowed under school logo T-shirt.
Pants, Skirts, Jumpers, and Shorts	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> REQUIRED MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY Required: BLACK or KHAKI pants, skirts, jumpers, or shorts. Shorts or skirts MUST be knee-length. NO spandex or bike shorts.
Shoes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> REQUIRED MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY Required: Any closed-toe shoes, sneakers, or tennis shoes. NO sandals, slippers, Crocs, or open-back or open-toed shoes.
Sweaters, Cardigans, Blazers, Sweatshirts, and Hoodies	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> OPTIONAL While in the school building, scholars may wear any BLACK, WHITE, or PURPLE solid color sweater, cardigan, blazer, sweatshirt, or hoodie. NO logos, words, or insignias. If a scholar chooses to wear a hoodie, they MAY NOT keep the hood on their head while in the school building.
