# Harper's Hybrid Learning Information

#### General Information

- Please call 216-838-3675 if you want to opt out of your learning choice before March 19<sup>th</sup>
- If you need help with transportation to Hybrid, please call 216-838-0954
- Hybrid students only come to Harper for their 2 assigned days.
- Prek-2nd: Start hybrid the week of March 15th
- 3rd-5th: Start hybrid the week of March 22nd
- Please UPDATE your contact information by contacting our front office prior to school starting.

#### Harper's School Day

- School Hours are 8:00 AM to 2:30 PM
- Must wear a face mask to enter the building
- No visitors will be permitted in the building unless it is an approved meeting by the front office team.
- Bus riders will enter building at 7:30-7:50 AM
- Car riders will be permitted to enter the building at 7:50 AM. Please arrive as close to 8:00 AM as possible.
- Car riders will be dismissed using the café doors.
- Car riders will have a hang tag with student's name, please do not leave your car.

#### Getting Ready for School

- Please check for symptoms prior to bringing them to Harper
- Please send child to school with a school appropriate face mask to wear for the entire school day.
- Students will be provided a backpack
- Ist to 5th graders MUST bring their district provided computer and the charger every day to school
- Uniforms are not required, however, students must wear school appropriate clothing
- Students can wear Harper Polo and/or Harper T-Shirts
- NO pajamas, No hoodies and NO open toed shoes

### Learning Schedules

- Only Prek, ED and MD will come to school 4 days a week
- All other students will return to school during their assigned 2 days a week

- Wednesdays will remain a virtual day for all students Health and Safety
  - CMSD will follow all guidelines for health and safety
  - Increased sanitation
  - Prepackaged meals for students, student can still pack their own lunch
  - Students eating socially distanced in classroom
  - Students will be monitored by a school nurse or medical professional
  - Social distancing throughout the school day, during lunch/breakfast and during recess
  - FACE MASKS MUST REMAIN ON FOR THE ENTIRE SCHOOL DAY
  - 2 scholars in the bathroom at a time, bathroom breaks will be taken as a class.
  - If students need to use bathroom outside of the class bathroom breaks, they will be walked to the bathroom by a staff member to ensure social distancing
  - Two-way communication will continue (our class will use Class Dojo as the main communication platform)
  - If a student tests positive, they will be taken to the Harper Care Center and we will follow all district policies and health guidelines.
