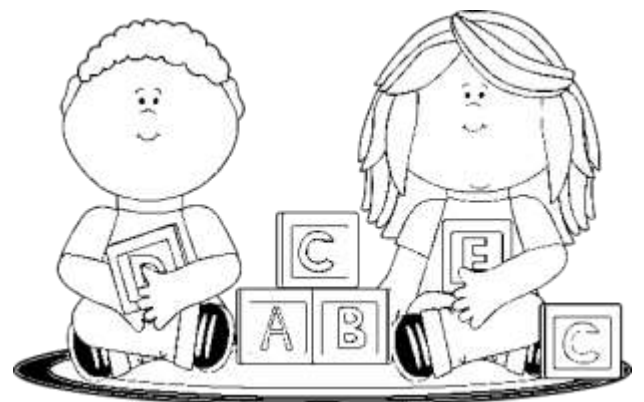
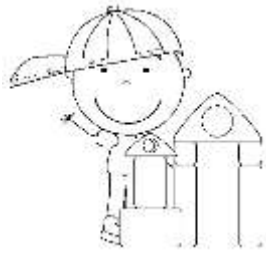


# PreK Supply List
