## Job Summary

Prepares entrees, vegetables, starches, and desserts following standardized recipes and menu directives. Accuracy in weighing and measuring food ingredients and portions. Serves a portion of the lunch tray line. Date, label and stores leftovers properly, keeping work area clean. Responsible for preparation of menu items for the next day, including pulling meats from freezer.

# Job Training and Knowledge

Initial on-the-job training, working with standardized recipes. Review of all good production, menus, therapeutic diets and cooking procedures. Training for proper sanitation techniques. Weekly production meetings with updates/in-services as needed.
