Field Trip Logistics:

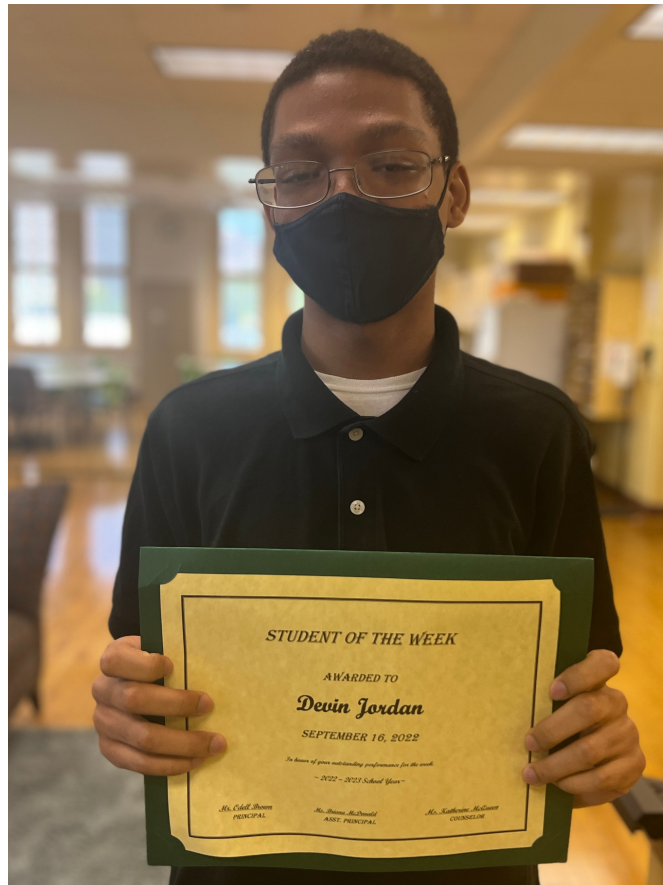

DEVIN JORDAN


