We have reserved a Fan Bus for students to attend our homecoming football game against Collinwood on Friday, October 7th. If you would like to ride the fan bus you must:

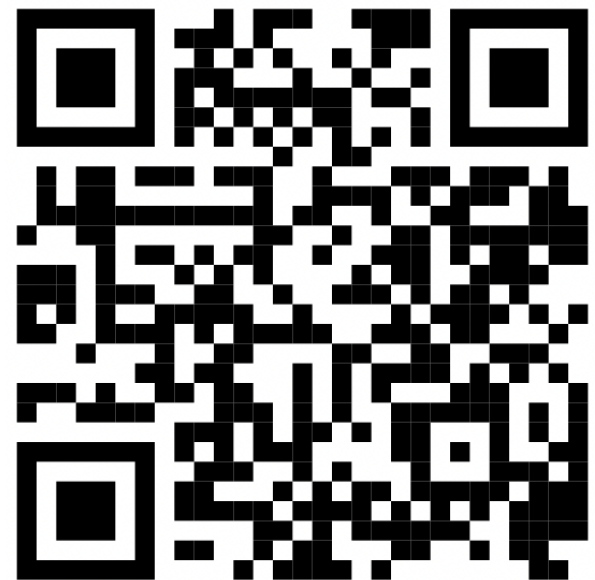
- 1) Complete the survey below by scanning the QR code

REDESIGNING CLEVELAND SCHOOL OF ARCHITECTURE AND DESIGN'S LOGO



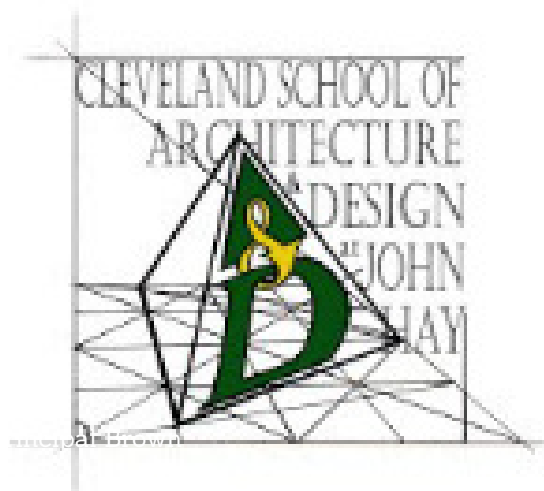

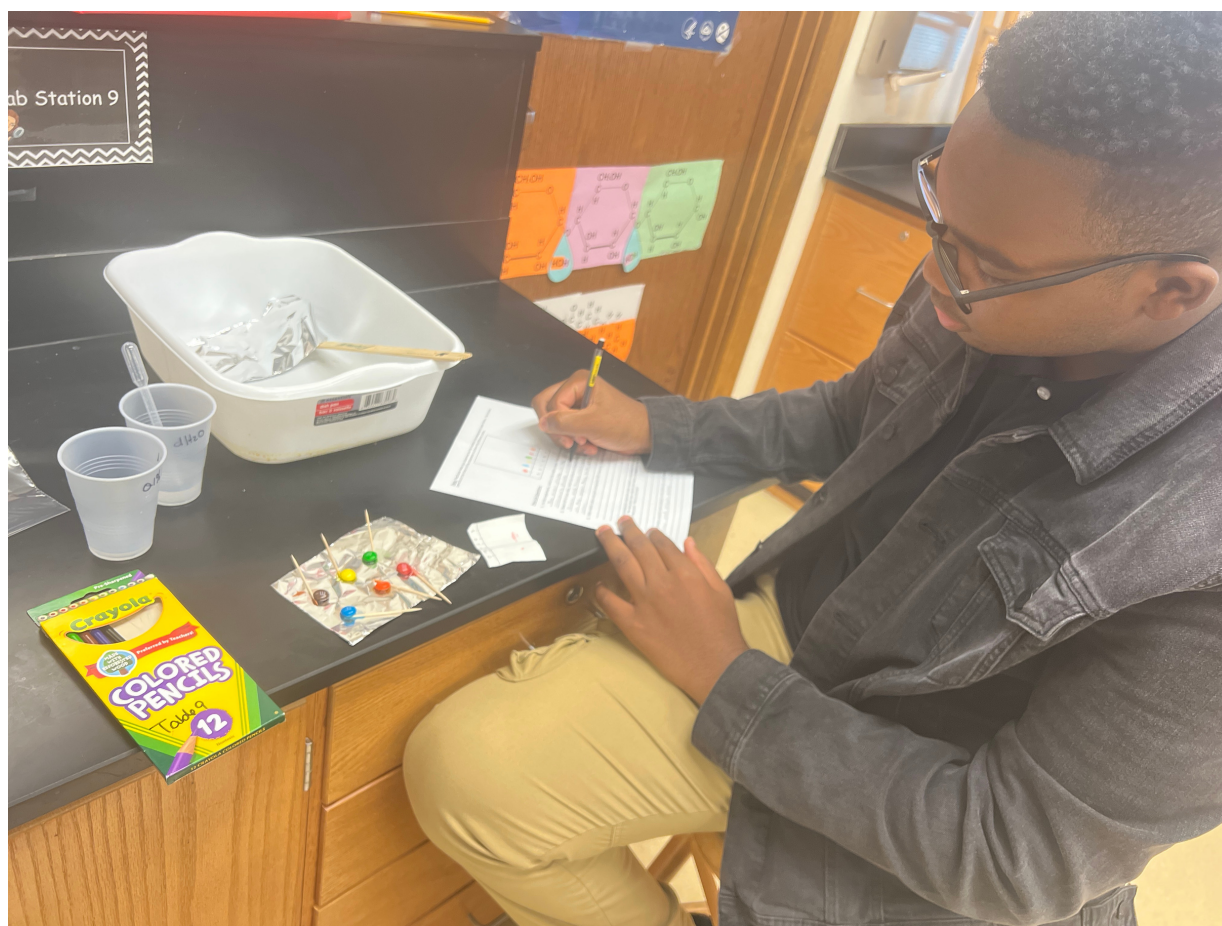
