### Application Pre-Screening

Criteria	Decision
If the application is submitted by an adult, there is evidence of student sponsorship	If no, application eliminated, do not score
If the application is for a travel experience, does the quote come from a district approved travel partner?	If no, application eliminated, do not score
Are students the primary beneficiary of the proposed materials/project/equipment?	If the application is for an opportunity for adults (college credit, professional development, etc.), do not score
Does any part of the plan conflict with board policy?	If there is a conflict, identify the policy that is not followed to share as feedback with the applicant. Application is eliminated, do not score
