A Parent's Guide to Law Enforcement Interactions

The Cleveland Metropolitan School District ("CMSD") is committed to an excellent education regardless of who they are or where they are from. CMSD also recognizes the rights that students and parents have pertaining to their child's information and have policies that protect your child's privacy and safety.

Directory Information Opt-Out:

Directory Information includes student's name, address, telephone number(s), date and place of birth, participation in officially recognized activities and sports, achievement awards or honors, student's weight and height if a member of an athletic team, major field of study, dates of attendance and date of graduation.

Directory information can be released to anyone without a parent's written consent unless this form is completed and returned to your child's school. Parents, guardians and adult students have the right to prevent the disclosure of directory information, except as otherwise provided by the Notification of Rights under FERPA for Elementary and Secondary Schools contained in the student code of conduct, pages 14-15. Communication with Parents/Guardians:

The district will attempt to communicate with the parent/guardian of the student in any situation that may arise. In the case of law-enforcement, the district will make every effort to communicate with the parent/guardian as permissible by law and the situation.

Directory information will be released to anyone without a parent's written consent unless this form is completed and returned to your child's school.
