Testing Logistics

- These are summative tests that measure how a student is developing his/her knowledge and skills as outlined by state standards.
- For all 3rd through 8th grade scholars not exempt due to an IEP.
- English/Language Arts to include Writing, Math, and Science for 5th and 8th grades.
- Required to be done In-Person.
- House Bill 3302.42 requires these assessments and maintains that students in an online school who fail to complete them should be returned to an in-person school.

Testing Logistics

- Testing will take place at John Adams HS.
- ELA goes from 4/8-4/25.
- Math and Science goes from 4/22-5/9.
- Testing will start at 9:30 promptly each day. Students must arrive at 9:00am. Testing will end at 2:00pm.
- Students may be dropped off (the adult may stay), take a passenger van from a cluster stop, or request RTA tickets.
- A breakfast snack and full lunch will be provided.
- Dates will be scheduled for all tests and families will need to sign-up via [Sign-Up Genius](#).

Testing Make-Up

- Each test has 2 parts. Students will test both on the same day.
- Test times vary between 1 hour and 15 minutes up to 1 hour and 45 minutes.
- ELA will include a writing prompt. 1 for 3rd-5th grade and 2 for 6th-8th grade. This accounts for 25-33% of the overall score.
- Math will include drag and drop, gridded response, short-answer and limited calculator usage.
- Science is only for 5th and 8th grade.

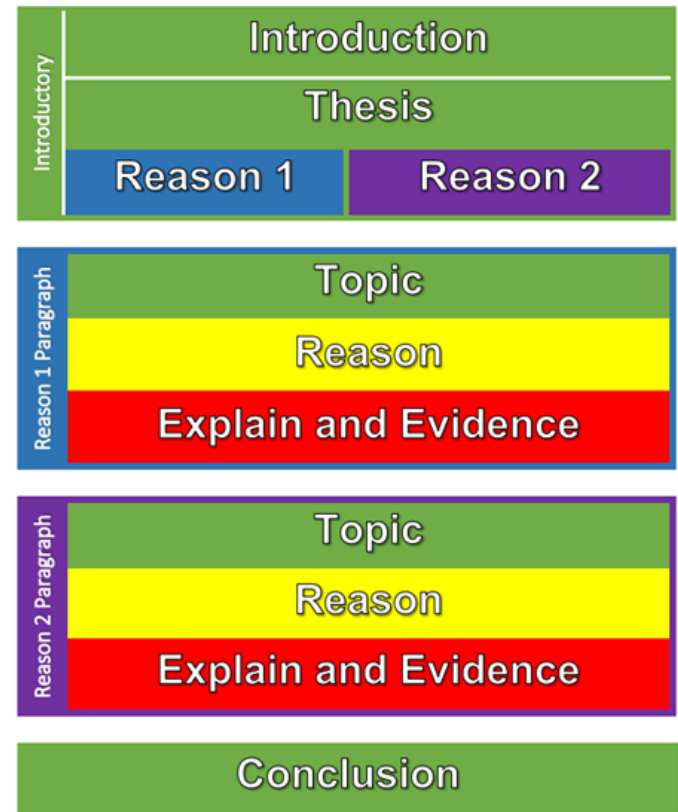
Step Up to Writing
