At the heart of CMSD's continued success is *The Cleveland Plan* – a blueprint for education reform that, since 2010, has earned state and national recognition for its bold approach to school reform.

The goal of *The Cleveland Plan* is to ensure that every student and every neighborhood has access to a high-quality education. The Plan is based on three key principles: Families choose the schools their children attend, schools are given flexibility in how education takes place and the District's central office provides support.

After *The Plan* went into effect, the District achieved rapid gains that outpaced those of districts across Ohio and the nation. The graduation rate – a key indicator – reached a series of record highs for CMSD, increasing from 52.2 percent in 2011 to 80.9 percent in 2021.

I am pleased to share the Cleveland Metropolitan School District's Academic Calendar, a publication mailed across the city to keep stakeholders informed of CMSD's activities and progress.

Progress did not come easily during the 2021-22 school year. A once-in-alifetime pandemic that we thought was coming under control stubbornly hung on and continues to lurk in the background. Returning to the classroom five days a week last fall, our scholars, families and educators struggled with anxiety. Attendance suffered.

But amid the turmoil, they persevered with the same resolve and resilience that propelled nearly a decade of significant gains made under The Cleveland Plan, our blueprint for education reform. Their spirit is helping us deliver on the promise I made last summer – to seize the disruption of the pandemic as an opportunity and emerge from it with a new way of learning, a system that is more fair, just and good for all learners.

Our Vision for Learning calls for moving away from "seat time" and measuring student progress through mastery of content. It calls for learning that occurs anywhere and anytime, considers a student's social, emotional and cultural wellbeing, and personalizes pathways to the future.

Our pledge is that with CMSD, students and families "Get More." The pages that follow outline and illustrate what that means: More joy and adventure, more arts and music, more voice and support in our schools and more to prepare students for the future. The list goes on, but in short, more of the stuff that engages students in their learning and inspires them to do their best.

None of this would be possible without a community that firmly believes in the value of education. In 2019, your commitment helped launched Say Yes to

Education Cleveland, a partnership that provides support services to our students and families and tuition scholarships for our graduates. Additional pieces continue to fall into place.

Thank you for your support of a bold vision that we believe will transform our public schools, our children's lives and our region.

Say Yes Cleveland provides:

- a scholarship for up to the full value of tuition, minus federal and state aid, to any public college, university or Pell-eligible training program in Ohio and more than 100 private colleges and universities across the country. To qualify, students must be continuously enrolled in a CMSD high school and live in the City of Cleveland or the District from ninth grade until graduation.
- comprehensive resources, including mentoring and family support services, to remove barriers to student success.

- reduce reading scores by 12 percent.
- reduce math scores by 15 percent.
- reduce a student's chances of remaining on track to graduation by 34 percent.
