



- No mention of physical education. Not all buildings are equipped (yet) with proper space, equipment, and electives. Plus physical activity improves academic/mental performance.
- Going to be a large number of teachers losing jobs. Allower Lower Corollment = less teachers. Sure, each building /program's budget should increase (student-based budgets), but that doesn't mean a principal will use that money for more teachers. Lastly, it's only a probability that consolidation, which will increase the budgets, will provide more or better opportunities for our students. Not all principals are similar and some are very poor, yet still hired. Oh! If elers sizes durease with mininal staff, expect academic progress the be slower/stagnant. If relationships are key, it is be more difficult of barger numbers. - Choices gave great. I've actually always liked CMJD being a district of choice. But what if a program is too far for a student or if their parents tell then that they need to go to a school doser to home? Then you'll have "mis-engaged" students in schools that don't want to be where they are at, which can hart accelence progress. - Seems like you are battling traditional schooling /ODE requirements, which should be done. Education will be well-rounded, but in this generation, it should stop by 8th or 9th grade.
