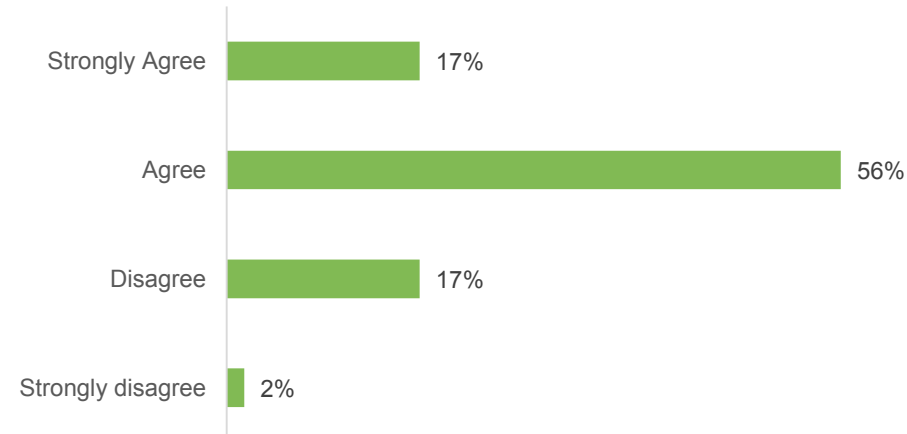

# 10/07 Meeting: Illustrative Input

**Identify the most important things that you want CMSD to consider within the decision-making process**

- **Programming, resources to match student/family wants and needs**
  - “If schools are combined, what programs will work best together?”
  - “What are they taking into account – other than the report card – like service learning, extra-curriculars, school culture?”
  - “Student & family feedback as priority; robust, competitive trades & scholarships (Say Yes); transportation needs (safe and reliable).”
  - “How the quality (building condition) affects the families’ choice of school.”
- **Interconnected identity of community and school**
  - “Schools that have strong neighborhood partnerships and potential to anchor their neighborhoods should be given consideration beyond school report card data.”
  - “Please consider how will the school benefit the community it sits in. How will we incorporate space for community to be a part of our schools?”
  - “We need to keep investment in the neighborhood for suitable investment.”

**Offer advice on how CMSD could best support the Board of Education in making these hard decisions and best support the community in communicating them**

- **Extensive and transparent communication**
  - “Find local influencers and get them on board to help disseminate the info”
  - “Meeting with staff and student about the changes and needs.”
  - “Break down data to make it palatable for students and their families.”
  - “Come to culturally relevant events.”
- **Be thoughtful about the personal side**
  - “Really get to know who you are serving. Yes, data is helpful but put a face to that data.”
  - “Consider how the changes will affect the structure of the community (feelings of community).”
  - “Be transparent about the possibilities.”
  - “Combining programs into campuses – what community/cultural factors need to be considered?”
