2. I understand how Academic Quality was defined in the Citywide Analysis and the data provided on this metric is clear and helpful to me.



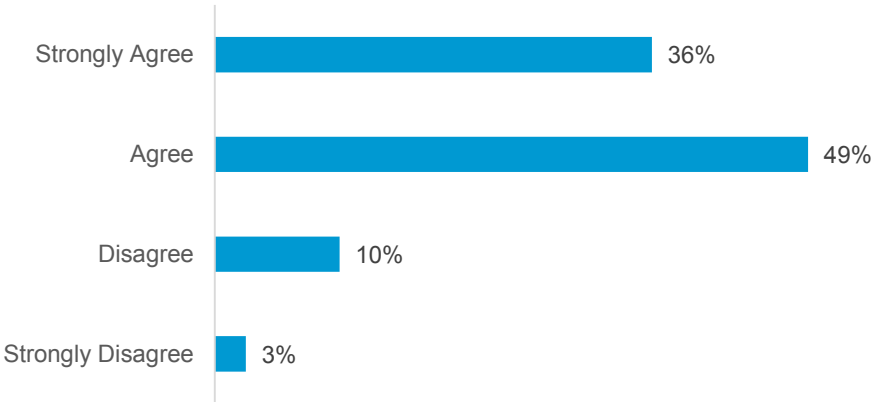

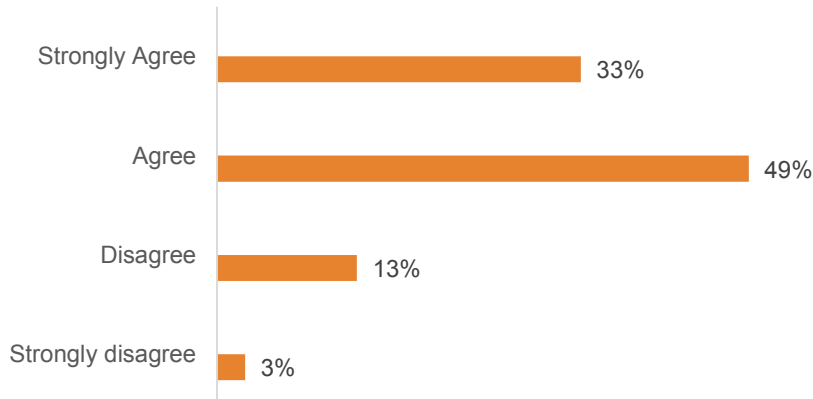

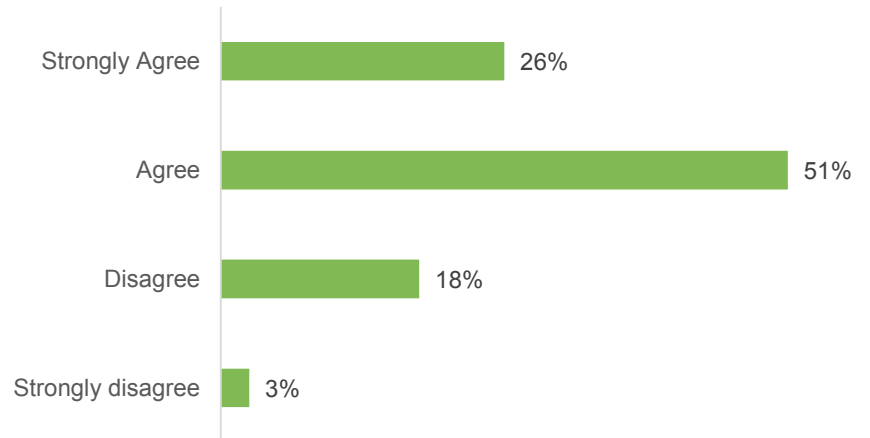

# 10/09 Meeting: Illustrative Input

**Identify the most important things that you want CMSD to consider within the decision-making process**

- **Addressing needs in programming, supports**
  - “Need to consider what programs students want – can benefit them – and then build/renovate/grow programs based on that.”
  - “Making sure to keep student morale positive and assuring that students feel as though they matter.”
  - “How do we equitably spread student and educator capital around a choice district?”
  - “Address cultural competency throughout the schools.”
- **Proximity & transportation**
  - “Relocating a school even a mile further than original location can be a safety concern.”
  - “Transportation to schools that will remain open after schools are closed.”
  - “Offer transportation to special programs that will allow students to get further to their school of choice.”
  - “Location of school in area where student population is high.”

**Offer advice on how CMSD could best support the Board of Education in making these hard decisions and best support the community in communicating them**

- **Go to the community**
  - “Partner with local churches, community centers.”
  - “Bring key stakeholders into conversations – mayor, councilmen, alumni, (etc.) – intentionally choose them and create a unified front so everyone knows it’s a shared decision – not just the district’s.”
  - “Present at community meetings; i.e. community collaborative meetings, ward meetings.”
  - “Ask scholars for their input.”
- **Keep the dialogue going**
  - “Articulate the positives, repeated and early.”
  - “Share data. Share the benefits of the decisions being made.”
  - “Work on increasing trust between district and community.”

However, as a partner, I've seen repeatedly that schools on these combined campuses do <u>not</u> share resources due to each school being in control of its own budget. If you're going to combine programs geographically, resources for joint extracurriculars should also be allocated.</p> <p>* I feel very strongly that both in the 9-12 as well as K-8 programs, alternative education programs need to be implemented to remove the "problem" kids from the traditional classrooms. This would give the rest of our scholars a better learning environment while providing a different / better / more appropriate / better equipped campus to handle those students who are unable to thrive in a traditional classroom / educational environment. The emphasis on attendance + avoiding suspensions means compromising the greater learning environment.</p>
