2. I understand how Academic Quality was defined in the Citywide Analysis and the data provided on this metric is clear and helpful to me.



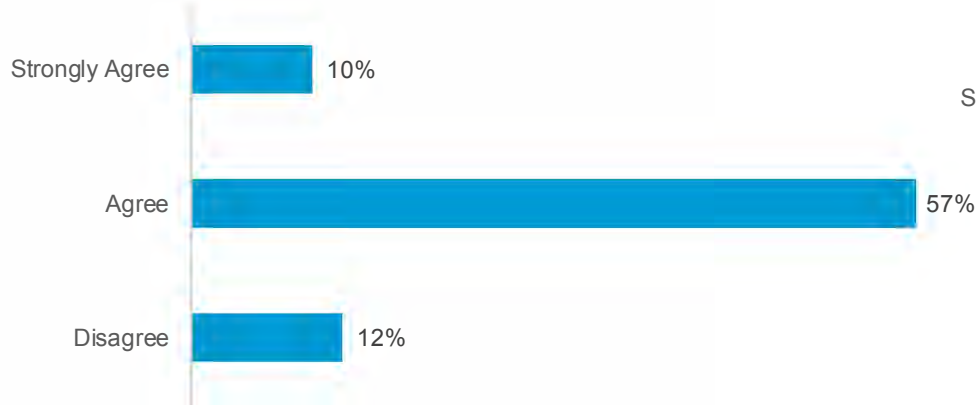
3. I understand how Enrollment and School Choice was defined in the Citywide Analysis and the data provided on this metric is clear and helpful to me.



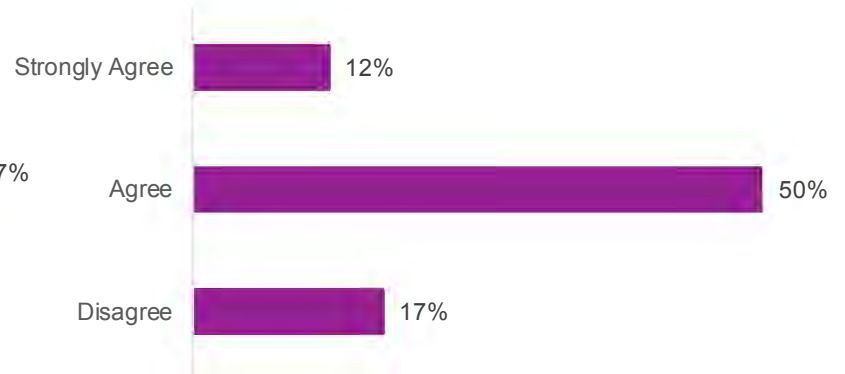

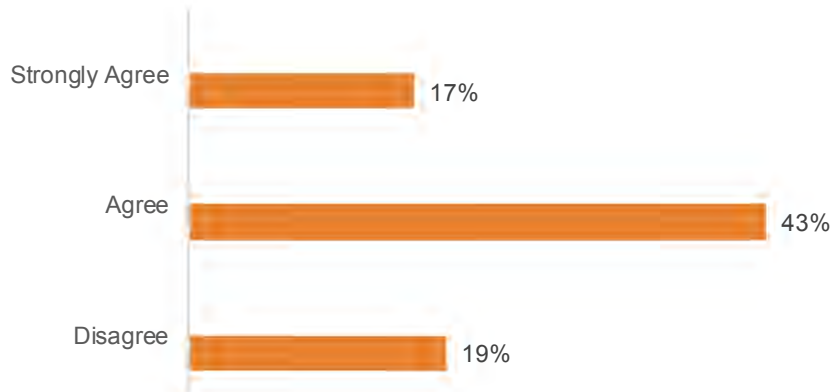

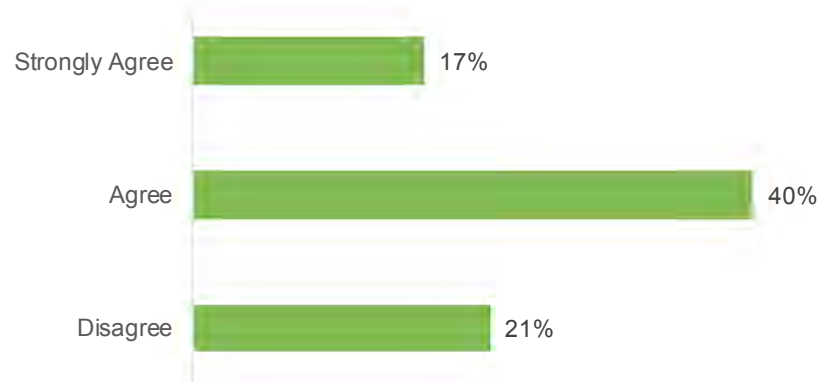

# 10/05 Meeting: Illustrative Input

**Identify the most important things that you want CMSD to consider within the decision-making process**

- **Access to more programming (especially trades) on east side**
  - “We want tech & vocational programs in our high schools.”
  - “Need more programs on the east side for students to have the same programs as west side.”
  - “Resources in proximity close to home (not too much travel for children) if they’d like to stay close to home.”
- **Student/ family voice**
  - “Ask the kids what they want.”
  - “True community voice; if east side residents demand more vocational programs, how can CMSD make it happen?”
  - “Have a forum with students to see what types of programs they will like to have in school.”
- **Stability**
  - “Effect on community stability.”
  - “Staff stability/stop staff turnover.”
  - “Need high schools in the neighborhoods.”

**Offer advice on how CMSD could best support the Board of Education in making these hard decisions and best support the community in communicating them**

- **Increase, diversify outreach**
  - “Community ambassadors to go door-to-door to interface with residents, or have tables at grocery stores, churches, barber shops, etc.”
  - “Engage parents and the word will spread itself.”
  - “Post meetings on YouTube, social media channels.”
  - “District has to assume the burden to reach the audience.”
  - “Info shared at parent drop-off, student performances, events.”
- **Remember importance of community**
  - “Shared use as well as restoring community hubs.”
  - “Need to include residents of the community.”
  - “Build trust; be warm, not just transparent.”
  - “Small businesses in neighborhood might be able to mentor & provide extra communication on direction.”
