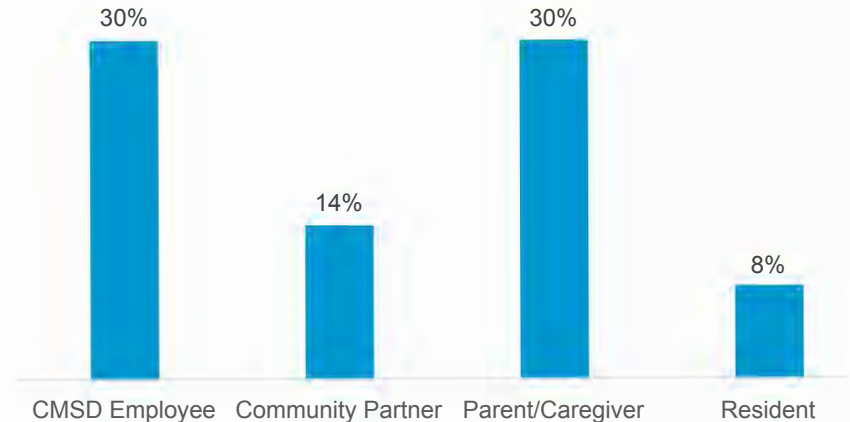

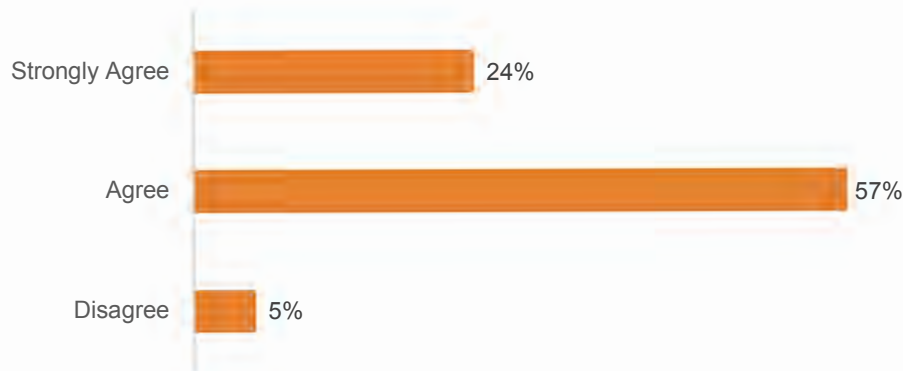

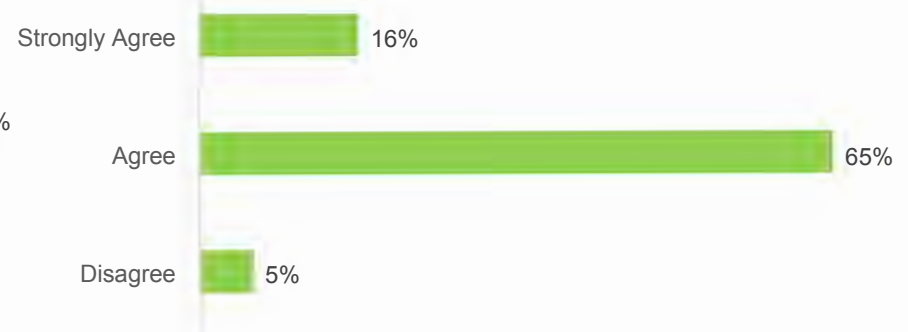

2. I understand how Academic Quality was defined in the Citywide Analysis and the data provided on this metric is clear and helpful to me.



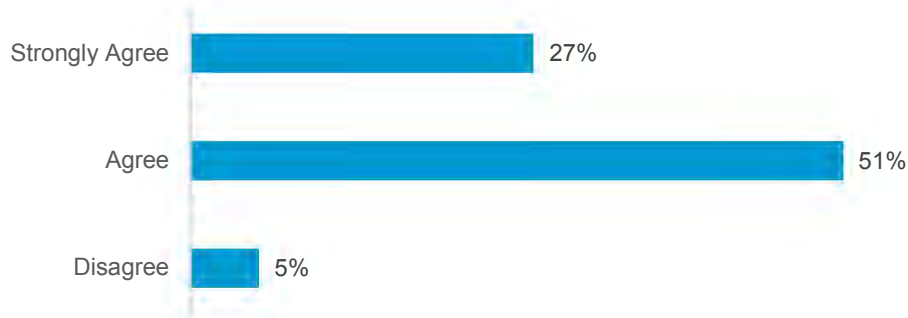
3. I understand how Enrollment and School Choice was defined in the Citywide Analysis and the data provided on this metric is clear and helpful to me.



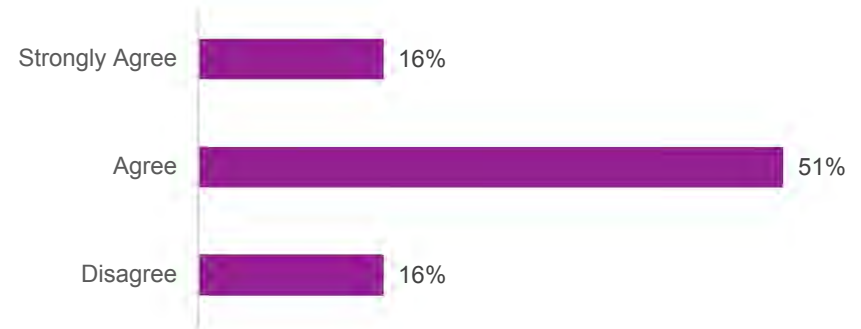

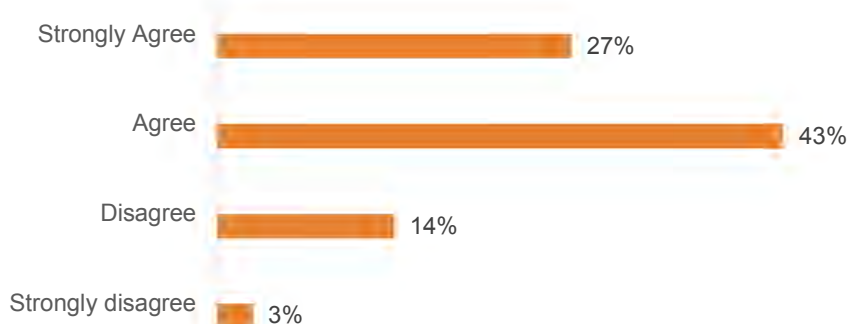

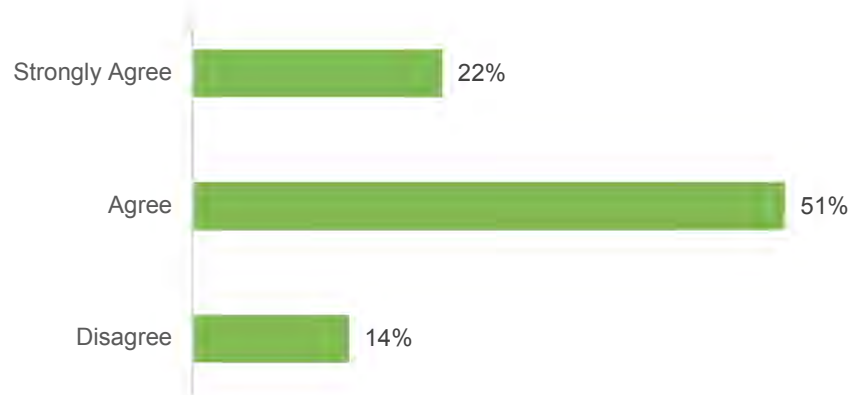

# 09/28 Meeting: Illustrative Input

**Identify the most important things that you want CMSD to consider within the decision-making process**

- **Need to ensure access to diverse, quality programs in all areas of the city**
  - “Trades in school, alternative education programming”
  - “Programs available in high school are limited in different schools across the district”
  - “Offer programs on both sides of town so students aren’t forced to go to closer school due to lack of transportation.”
- **Listed factors to consider**
  - Student voice, addressing bullying/building safety, transportation, efficiency, community partnerships, open door policy
- **Prioritize strategically and openly**
  - “Focus on future, not just today; focus on needs, not personal wants.”
  - “Future career projections”
  - “Clearly set the criteria for prioritization; maximize facilities for most students, even if it means fewer schools”
- **Community input, community perspective**
  - “With the full community in each neighborhood”
  - “Need to consider how the city and the neighborhoods and community partners work together”

**Help CMSD understand how you would make the decision**

**Offer advice on how we help the community to make hard decisions**

- **Consistent and transparent communication**
  - “Be honest and update constantly; provide complete rationale.”
  - “Communicate options that give the communities reasons to stay in the district (extracurricular programming, resources for special needs, etc.)”
  - “Meet parents where they are; ‘communication on the curb’”
  - “Look for partners – teachers and community members who buy in – to convey the message.”

- **Clear, understandable message**
  - “Visual demonstration of school building problems”
  - “The costs of empty seats – financial, educational & learning, culture in schools/community, etc.”
  - “Communicate the benefits, no matter the outcome.”

  - “Specific family meetings for all students affected; multiple opportunities to share information.”
  - “Don’t assume that the people who don’t show up are indifferent to what happens in their school/community.”
