





3. I understand the need for long term planning (because of population changes, the future of work, changes in the needs of the community, etc.)




2. My engagement in the Long Term Planning process thus far could best be described as:





 Student safety must be prioritized in planning for the consolidated schools (e.g. Glenville and East Tech).

- "With regards to blending Collinwood/Glenville/MLK, this is a recipe for conflict as these communities have had a long (decades) history of bad blood between them."
- "How are you addressing student safety?"
- "Safety how many guards?"
- Public transportation to consolidated schools (e.g. Glenville and East Tech) is a concern.
 - "Increase bussing during transition. Maybe for a grow in period."
 - "Can an arrangement be made with RTA to provide special services/routes to address the increased transportation of children to and from various neighborhoods? Having pick up and drop off locations exclusively for CMSD students only."
 - "Consider having an agreement with RTA that will have busses that only transport students."
 - "Transportation How are they getting to/from school? RTA is dangerous."
- Many offered ideas to help smooth the transition for the students, some involving student-led change initiatives.
 - "To help with school transitions, begin having sign up campaigns/events where students are leading the recruitment events."
