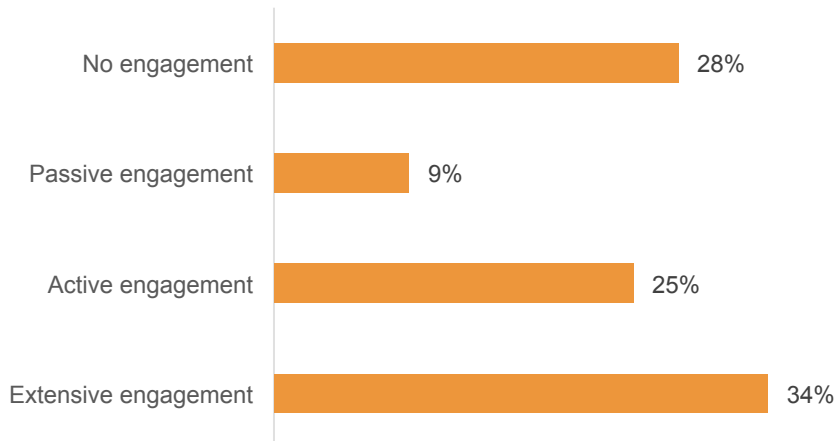

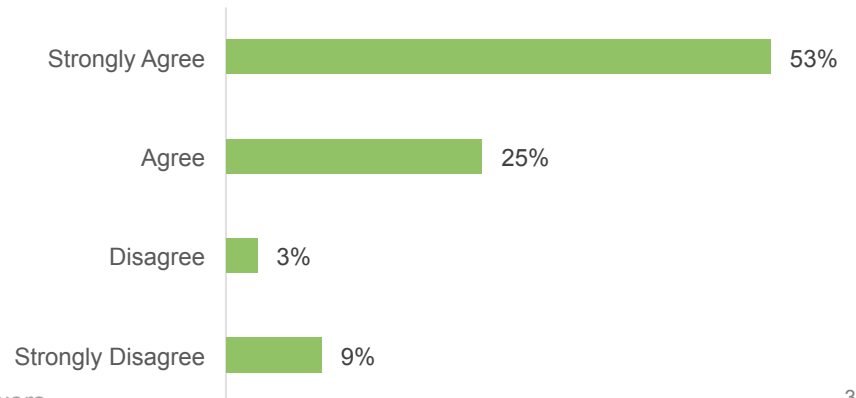

2. My engagement in the Long Term Planning process thus far could best be described as:



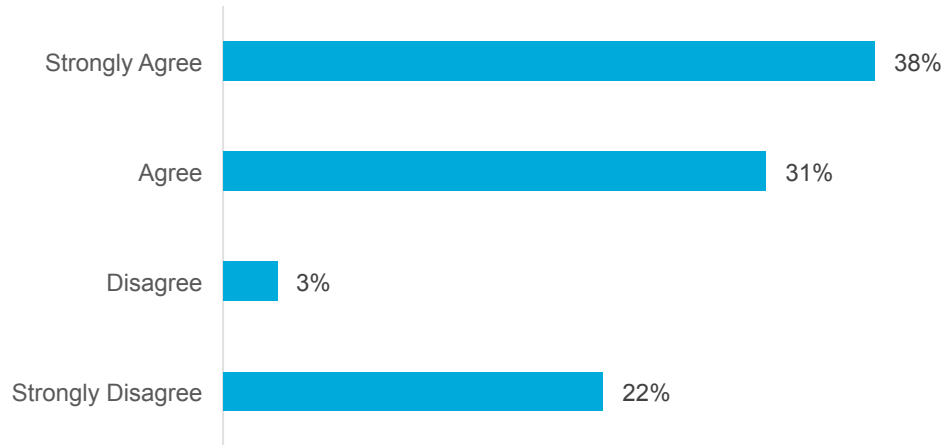

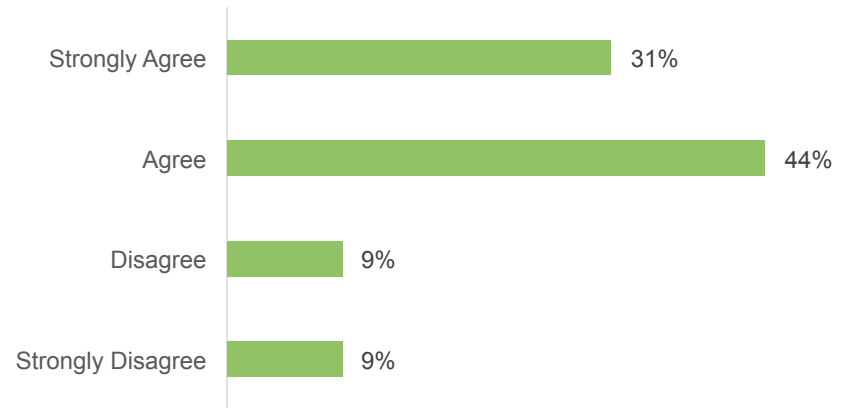

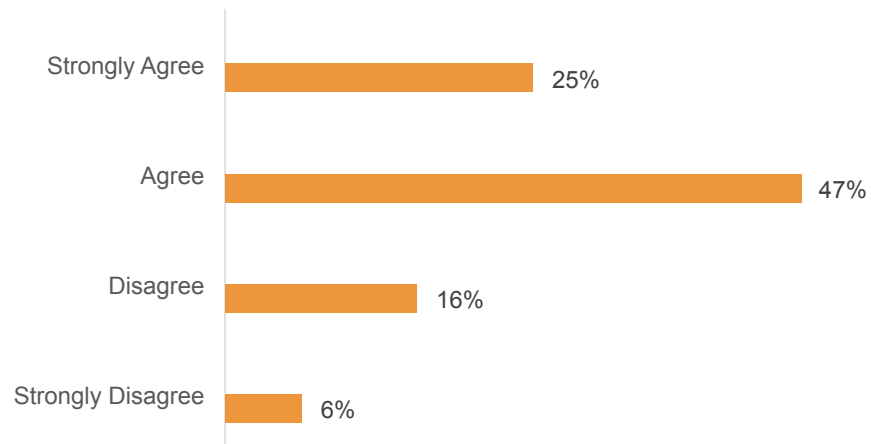

- **Both questions as well as ideas exist around future of unused buildings.**
 - “What will happen to the Jane Addams building?”
 - “What will happen with New Tech West (old Brooklawn) building once phased out?”
 - “Use Walton for swing site for LW.”
 - “Booker... as a swing site for Clark/Walton.”
- **Scheduling at shared campuses must be thought out with care.**
 - “If you stagger time for start and end of high schools, please consider this as it relates to sports. Some schools... sacrifice classroom time on a regular basis for sporting events.”
 - “I totally agree w/staggering start + end times of area high schools but athletics has to be addressed.”

*prevent lack of accountability w/ K-8. How can we prevent K-8 students from being pushed to the next level if they lack the skills & behavior for the next grade of learning. This leads to students entering high school not prepared for the rigor that is in place to prepare students for college.

*could the unique programs offered be application only to ensure students and programs succeed in fulfilling what the goal of the unique programs entails. Have each high school have a neighborhood school & 1 unique program. This could strengthen neighborhoods by improving & bringing back neighborhood schools & still offering choice.

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As a former secretary/administrative assistant, I would not recommend encouraging our young people to pursue that field. I am still in touch with former colleagues and they inform me that these ~~positions~~^{positions} are being phased out. While I have an associates degree, most places were looking for people with a bachelors degree. Professional services firms are using "pods or pools" of secretaries and squeezing more than admin/secretary type work out of these employees. They are even forcing managers and others to handle their own administrative work. ~~As they~~ As secretaries leave, they are not being replaced and work is being divided among those left behind, ~~the~~ creating more stress in the workplace (and no increase in pay.) The kids these days can not handle the level of stress that is put on current administrative/secretary assistants.

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- What kind of effect does the District anticipate on students' overall attendance and/or ability to be at school on time every day with the shift in schools' locations? How will gang activity be impacted?
- One way to combat the downside of small schools (limited electives, sport teams, clubs, etc.) is to have small schools that share a building/campus work together to share teachers and resources. Ex, School A pays half the teacher's salary and School B pays the other half, and the teacher is a "traveling" teacher. That way, more electives (art, music, JROTC, AP, sign language) or related services (media centers) can be available to all students on campus. Small schools should be encouraged to do this. That does require some bell schedule or class schedule coordination, but above all, it is only possible if all small schools are all on the same school calendar - all year round or all extended or all traditional. Otherwise, students cannot access the upside of viably enrolled schools.
- JFK was split into 2 small schools beginning the 2014-15 school year. Are these small schools closing and merging into one school again, and being redesigned again? What changes will be made with all of these upcoming consolidations and potential redesigns to ensure these shifts will be well-supported and last for an extended rather than brief amount of time?

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
