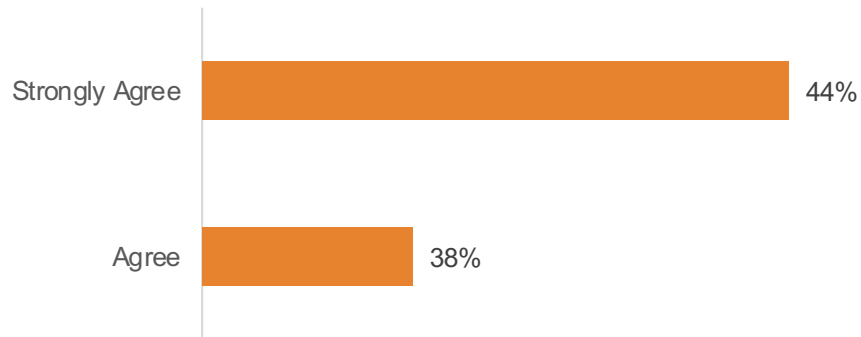
2. My engagement in the Long Term Planning process thus far could best be described as:



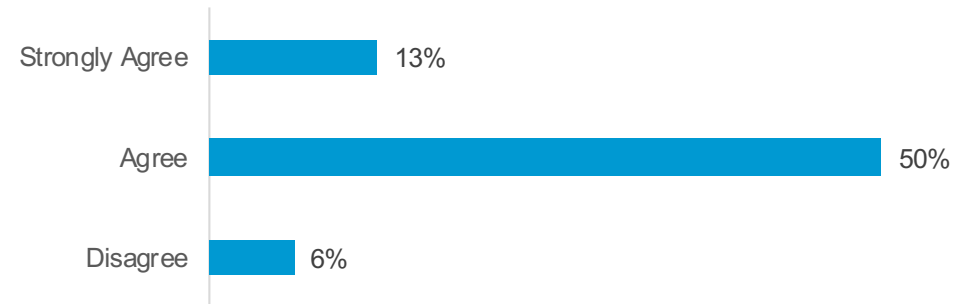

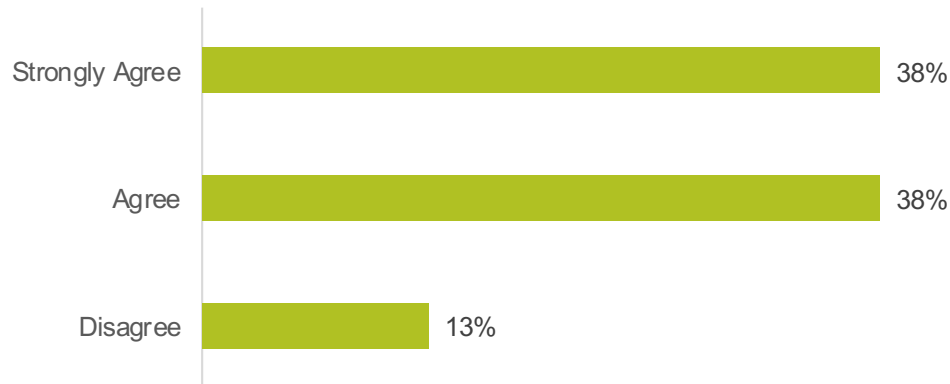
3. I understand why the District has chosen to make certain recommendations that affect my region.



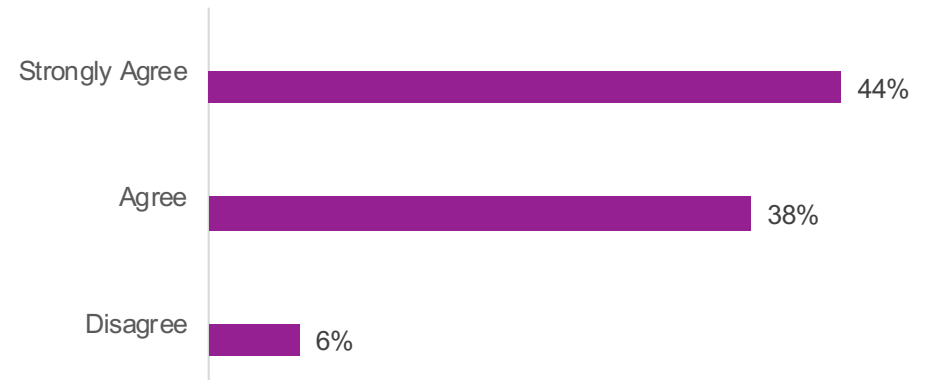
4. I understand why the District has chosen to NOT make certain recommendations that affect my region (that I may have been expecting).

Southeast Regional Meeting: Illustrative Input

Recommendations being made by the District

- Possibility of changes to recommendations
 - *"If this year's report card shows significant progress, would that affect the decision to close...?"*
 - *"If one of the D schools that are closing increases to a C or if enrollments increase, are there any plans to revisit the closing of these schools?"*
- Attention needed to ongoing/anticipated neighborhood development
 - "Am glad to hear that this planning process will be ongoing & can reflect the growing population anticipated from new development"
 - "I'm concerned that there is a significant vacuum in North Broadway & Hyacinth (N. Slavic Village) with closure of Willow"
 - *"Have you met with...CDCs to find out how the plan impacts each individual neighborhood plan?"*
- Say Yes considered?
 - "Was the implementation of Say Yes considered when these plans were created?"

Recommendations NOT being made by the District

- Eliminating K-8 model
 - "Dismantle K-8 model! Look at districts that work."
 - "Middle schools"

Implementation of Recommendations

- Plan/timing for redevelopment of unused buildings
 - *"There is an urgent need for a redevelopment plan for the Willow (and Fullerton) school site."*
 - "Specific timing for demolition or reuse of Fullerton. Dates certainly need to be set."
- Need for strong communication to students, parents, staff, community partners
 - *"I hope that as decisions are made & transition takes place students, families, and employees are kept up to date so they can plan appropriately."*
 - *"I'm concerned about lack of communication from CMSD [...] about building plans despite our repeated outreach."*

Timing of Recommendations

- Appreciation of buffer time ahead of actions
 - *"I appreciate the transparency of announcing these closings/mergers ahead of time."*
 - *"A sufficient timeline has been established to properly communicate changes."*
 - *"...good to know you are giving time to the staff, parents, and students."*
- Possibility of amended timing?
 - "If precipitous drop in enrollment happens in closing schools, will you move faster?"
 - *"The purported savings could be greater with a shortened timeline."*
