VOLUNTEER JOB DESCRIPTIONS

Job Title: Volunteer Registration Table

Job Description: Sign in volunteers and check for completion of all required volunteer forms

Job Title: Greeters/Cheering Crew

Job Description: Greet teams/students/runners as they enter the CSU PE building

Job Title: Information Table

Job Description: Assist volunteers, guests, teachers with program information and directions

Job Title: Team Registration Table

Job Description: Working with each school teacher, make sure that all students are signed in.

Job Title: T-shirt Distribution Table

Job Description: Distribute t-shirts for the teams, teachers and volunteers.

Job Title: Sponsor Sign-In Table

Job Description: Facilitate signing of the sponsor boards by the marathon students and team captains (i.e. Rite Aid Cleveland Marathon, CDPH, YMCA of Greater Cleveland, Second Sole, etc.)

Job Title: Photographer Assistant/Team Photo Table

Job Description: Assist photographer with the logistics of team photos.

Job Title: Refreshments

Job Description: Help manage the distribution of breakfast and lunch to students and volunteers.

Job Title: 1.2 Team Managers

Job Description: Team nanagers are assigned to specific schools, they will assist the teacher with all aspects of student activities and logistics.

Job Title: Transportation Volunteer

Job Description: Assist CMSD Transportation Coordinator with incoming and departing CMSD busses from our staging area at CSU Woodling gym.

Job Title: Gear Check Volunteers

Job Description: Assist with the logistics of transportating 10k, half marathon and full marathon students belongings from the downtown YMCA to the CSU Gymnasium on the designated bus.

Job Description: Make sure students are where they should be while in transition between the auditorium, eating breakfast/lunch, and gym activities.

Job Description: Cheer on runners along the marathon route and at finish line.
