## Did you know that.

..........Workday requires detailed itemization on all purchase orders. Let's assume a buyer needs to purchase 200 math books, 300 science textbooks and 100 Dell laptops.

Workday requires itemization of all purchases with a unit cost and quantity for each line item (see below).

## Workday Purchase Order

| Item | Required <br> Quantity | Cost per <br> Item | Workday <br> Units/ <br> Quantity | Unit Cost | Total Cost |
| :--- | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| Math Textbooks | 200 | $\$ 10.00$ | 200 | $\$ 10.00$ | $\$ 2,000.00$ |
| Science Textbooks | 300 | $\$ 15.00$ | 300 | $\$ 15.00$ | $\$ 4,500.00$ |
| Dell Laptops | 100 | $\$ 600.00$ | 100 | $\$ 600.00$ | $\$ 6,000.00$ |

To ensure your purchase orders are entered correctly, and may be processed for invoicing and payment; remember that the all goods must be itemized with the correct quantity and unit cost.
