**Notes** (MYP =  $9^{th}$  &  $10^{th}$  Grade; DP =  $11^{th}$  &  $12^{th}$  Grade):

- Arrival & Breakfast Times The first period of the day starts at 8:15 AM and students are expected to be in the building with enough time to be in the classroom ready to learn at 8:15 AM. The school will open and breakfast will be available in the cafeteria at 7:50 AM.
- Tardiness Students arriving after 8:15 AM are tardy and must sign in in the main office.
- **Dismissal Times** Students are dismissed at 3:15 PM everyday. Students who are not engaged in official school-sponsored activities or who do not have the prior permission from a staff member *and* parent are expected to leave the school premises by 3:25 PM.
- CAS / Intervention The CAS/Intervention period on Monday is a time where students and staff will be able to provide and engage in intervention / support and also "CAS" enrichment activities. Students will have the opportunity to request preferences for these activities on a quarterly basis, with students who are not meeting "promotion criteria" subject to mandatory interventions if requested by their teachers.
- **IB Core / Core Plus** Between Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday, MYP students will have their IB Core class three times a week and either Health or College & Career Readiness on the fourth day. Schedules will vary according to a student's advisory group.
- Early Sign-Out Campus International respectfully requests that parents and caregivers make every attempt to avoid "signing out" their child prior to dismissal. When circumstances require a student to leave early, only a custodial parent may sign out a student or give advanced written permission to the school for another adult with verified identification to do so on their behalf.

## Pick-Up, Drop-Off, & Parking

The Cole Center parking lot is small, so we ask families and visitors that drive to adhere to strict guidelines in order to ensure that pick-up and drop-off are as smooth as possible.

- Please <u>enter</u> the parking lot only from E 30<sup>th</sup> St.
- The Cole Center Parking Lot operates as only a one-way circle during <u>drop-off and pick-up times</u>. Parents may line up during the following pick-up and drop-off times (single lane only):
  - o Drop-Off: 7:50 AM 8:30 AM
  - o Pick-Up: 3:00 PM 3:30 PM
  - O At all other times, we ask families and visitors to park in the lot unless they are *only* dropping off a student.
- You may exit the parking lot back onto E. 30<sup>th</sup> St. after going around the circle. You may also exit by turning right onto Chester Ave through the north side of the parking lot.
- Visitor parking is available in front of the main entrance to the building.
- For all athletic and other after-school activities located at another site, students must be picked up directly from that site unless otherwise agreed with the coach / advisor.

## Public Transportation Information

School buses are not provided for high school students in CMSD, but all CMSD students are provided with an RTA pass good for use on RTA buses and rapid transit lines (please check schedules at <u>riderta.com</u>). CIHS is accessible by RTA bus lines on Superior Ave (#3), Payne Ave (#38), Euclid Ave (Health Line), Cedar Ave (#8), and Community College Ave / Quincy Ave (#11, #14, #15). While the **Euclid Ave Health Line** is unquestionably the most convenient bus lines, the other lines listed are no more than a 10-15 minute walk from the school via E. 30th Street. Students can easily transfer to these lines from any of the other bus lines that serve downtown and Public Square, including:

- #79 & #79A (serving the West Side via Fulton Rd.),
- #81 (serving Tremont and the West Side via Storer Ave and W 98th St),

The following buses and express buses serve the Stephanie Tubbs Jones Transit Center at Prospect and E 22nd Street (a 10-15 minute walk from the school):

- #51 A-B-C (serving the Southwest suburbs and the near West Side coming up W 25th St),
- Express buses coming from the West & Southwest Suburbs: #55 A-B-C (Lakewood, Bay Village, Westlake), #53F (North Royalton, Broadview).
