CONSENT IS...

- a clear and enthusiastic "yes";
- an active, voluntary,
- and verbal agreement;
- a process, which must
- be asked for every step
- of the way.

CONSENT CAN ALWAYS BE WITHDRAWN

WHAT IS "FREE AND INFORMED" CONSENT?

Someone is able to give their free and informed consent if they:

- Know what they are consenting to;
- Are able to choose whether or not to do something;
- Know what their feelings are about the particular situation;
- Are able to communicate their choice without coercion (either a 'yes' or 'no' is acceptable...not refusing is not the same as consent);
- Are able to understand if something is harmful;
- ♣ Are able to prevent being harmed, physically or emotionally, by another.

Consent should always come before contact with another person's body, whether sexual or not.

No one should touch another without their consent.
