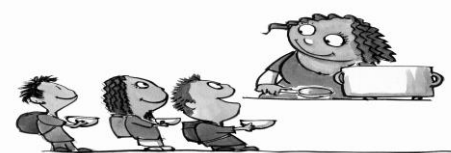

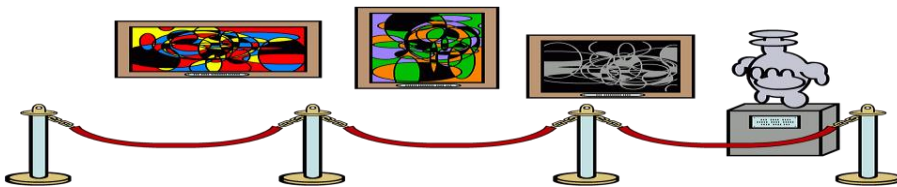
Who: Riverside's Student Artist
