




Graduation Ceremony

Graduation Requirements for 2019



Additional Options for Graduation

If a student has not earned the 18 required OST points they may try to qualify for one of the additional graduation options.

Option 1

You must take and pass courses that are your curriculum requirements and take all seven end-of-course exams. If you receive a score of "1" or "2" on any math or English Language Arts test, you must retake the test at least once.

Additionally, you must meet at least two of the below requirements:

- 93% attendance rate during 12th grade
- Earn 2.5 GPA on 4.0 scale during 12th grade
- Complete a capstone project during 12th grade
- Complete 120 hours of community service or work experience during 12th grade
- Earn 3 or more CCP credits at any time during high school

- Earn a score of a 3 or higher for an AP course any time during high school
- Earn a WorkKeys exam score of 3 or higher on each of 3 test sections
 - Earn a State Board-approved industryrecognized credential that equal at least 3 points
- Meet Ohio Means Jobs Readiness Seal requirements

Option 2

Students must take and pass courses that constitute the curriculum requirements and take all seven end-of-course exams.

Students must finish a career-technical program that includes at least four courses in a single career pathway and complete

<u>at least one of the options below:</u>

- Earn a total score of Proficient or better based on all career-technical exams or test modules;
- Earn an industry-recognized credential or credentials that equal 12 points;
- Complete a workplace experience totaling 250 hours with evidence of positive evaluations.

Capstone

- All seniors are required to complete a capstone project within their ELA class.
- ▶ 12th grade ELA is a graduation required course.
- Capstone projects need to be related/connected to your CTE pathway.
- Seniors received copies of the Capstone requirements. They are also being sent out via Jupiter and we have copies here today.
