## • SENIOR DUES ARE \$125.00.

- Senior dues are mandatory. They cover the cost of many events and items including, but not limited to the following:
  - ✓ Senior Shirt
  - ✓ Senior Edgewater Field Trip/Lunch
  - ✓ Senior Luncheon
  - ✓ Graduation Cap and Gown
  - ✓ Graduation Costs (i.e. flowers, food, programs)
- Senior dues can only be paid with cash or by money order. If you choose to use a money order, please make it out to "Max S. Hayes High School."
- All money is **<u>non-refundable</u>** and must be handed directly to Ms. Dalveren, Ms. Kiousis or a building administrator. When dues are paid a receipt will be issued.
- Seniors that do not pay their dues will not be able to participate in senior activities (including graduation).
- All senior dues must be received on or before April 26<sup>th</sup>, 2019.
- Prom is <u>not</u> included. Separate information (detailing the cost of prom) will be distributed closer to the spring. Prom
  is scheduled for Friday, May 3<sup>rd</sup>.
- Dues can be paid in one lump sum or broken down into payments.
- Dues will only be accepted in the cafeteria from 7:30AM to 7:50AM and 11:40AM to 12:20PM on the following dates:
  - ✓ January 25<sup>th</sup> and 29<sup>th</sup>
  - ✓ February 1<sup>st</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup>
  - ✓ March 1<sup>st</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, and 20<sup>th</sup>
  - April 5<sup>th</sup>, 18<sup>th</sup>, 23<sup>rd</sup>, 24<sup>th</sup>, 25<sup>th</sup>, and 26<sup>th</sup>
