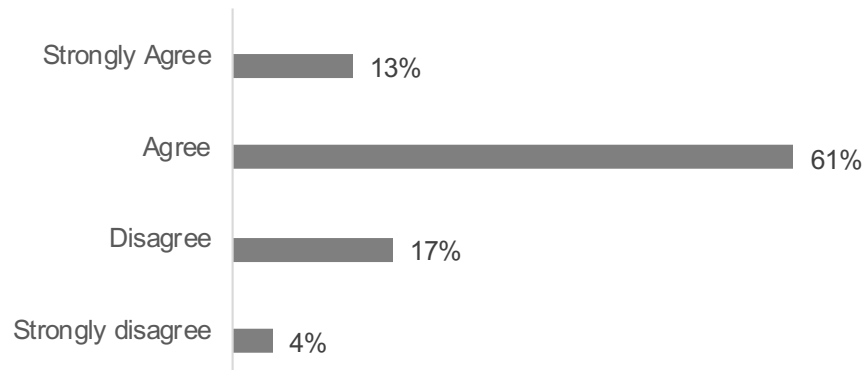

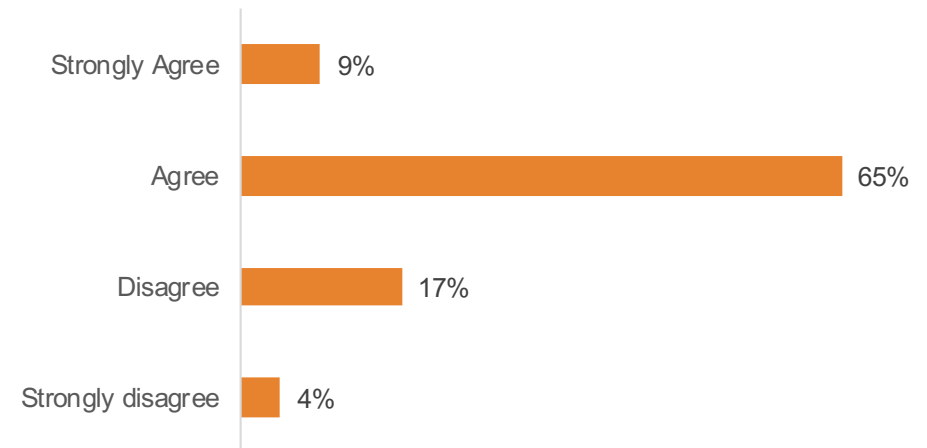

# East Regional Meeting: Illustrative Input

## Academic Quality



- How do external factors affect academic quality?
  - “Does academic quality correlate w/community ‘externalities’ i.e. lead pipes, lead paint, housing insecurity?”
  - “The schools that have the lowest academics quality or lowest grade on school report card are the ones where there’s the highest lead population.”
- Quality of instruction and/or standards needs improved
  - “The quality of academics are subpar. We have valedictorians that can’t put a sentence together.”
  - “How are kids passing? Some 8<sup>th</sup> graders couldn’t even spell the name of the school they attend.”

## Enrollment and Choice



- We need to better promote our offerings
  - “Promote the programs that we have in the district.”
  - “Let’s go door to door on a campaign. Let’s make Cleveland great again – CGA!”
- Transportation is a key factor in choice
  - “Transportation issue”
  - “Consider more vocational ed so that transport is not necessary.”

## Program Viability



- Middle schools should be re-introduced
  - “Bring back middle schools.” (2x)
- Vocational education needs expanded
  - “Schools do not offer trade/career opportunities like they used to.”
  - “Provide the same (vocational) programs you have on the west side.”
  - “Need vocational school... here at East Tech.”

## Building Use and Condition



- The district has too many buildings
  - “Can you all stop opening up so many schools; work with what we have.”
  - “Combine some schools together, if possible.”
  - “There are too many buildings!”
- Consider alternate uses for existing building space
  - “Available space is an opportunity. Invite in day care and other non-profits or even for-profits, charter schools.”
  - “Can some of the older buildings be used to provide housing (emergency) for families with school age/enrolled children?”

## Process and Timeline

- Consider student voices in this process
  - “Let’s replicate a meeting like today... and have key players/stakeholders present to listen to our students.”
  - “Let’s ask the students what they want.”
  - “Make sure you get more student involvement and feedback.”
